River Town Peter Hessler, 2001 When Peter Hessler went to China in the late 1990s he expected to spend a couple of peaceful years teaching English in the town of Fuling on the Yangtze River But what he experienced the natural beauty cultural tension and complex process of understanding that takes place when one is thrust into a radically different society surpassed anything he could have imagined Hessler observes firsthand how major events such as the death of Deng Xiaoping the return of Hong Kong to the mainland and the controversial construction of the Three Gorges Dam have affected even the people of a remote town like Fuling Poignant thoughtful and utterly compelling River Town is an unforgettable portrait of a place caught mid river in time much like China itself a country seeking to understand both what it was and what it will one day become
