Svoblik, 2012-09-17 What drives politics in dictatorships Milan W Svoblik argues authoritarian regimes must resolve two fundamental conflicts Dictators face threats from the masses over which they rule the problem of authoritarian control Secondly from the elites with whom dictators rule the problem of authoritarian power sharing Using the tools of game theory Svoblik explains why some dictators establish personal autocracy and stay in power for decades why elsewhere leadership changes are regular and institutionalized as in contemporary China why some dictatorships are ruled by soldiers as Uganda was under Idi Amin why many authoritarian regimes such as PRI era Mexico maintain regime sanctioned political parties and why a country's authoritarian past casts a long shadow over its prospects for democracy as the unfolding events of the Arab Spring reveal Svoblik complements these and other historical case studies with the statistical analysis on institutions leaders and ruling coalitions across dictatorships from 1946 to 2008 **The**

International Politics of Authoritarian Rule Oisín Tansey, 2016 Autocrats must overcome a range of challenges as they seek to gain and maintain political power including the threat that comes from both rival elites and discontented publics The International Politics of Authoritarian Rule examines the ways in which international forces can encourage and assist autocratic actors in overcoming these challenges Often autocratic incumbents are strengthened in power by events on the international stage and by the active support of international allies The book offers a typology of different international forms of influence on authoritarianism and examines the ways in which external forces shape autocratic rule at the domestic level The typology distinguishes between three broad forms of international influence passive influences unintended consequences and active forms of external autocratic sponsorship The book focuses in particular on the latter category and examines intentional autocratic sponsorship in the post Cold War period A central contribution of the book is to address the question of how international autocratic sponsorship can bolster authoritarian rule It highlights the ways in which international sponsorship can contribute to authoritarian practices in three significant ways by increasing the likelihood that authoritarian regimes will pursue authoritarian practices such as coups repression or election fraud by contributing to the implementation of those practices and finally by shielding autocratic actors from international punishment after such practices are pursued External sponsorship can thus lower the costs of authoritarian behaviour and protect and shield authoritarian regimes from the negative consequences of their actions Oxford Studies in Democratization is a series for scholars and students of comparative politics and related disciplines Volumes concentrate on the comparative study of the democratization process that accompanied the decline and termination of the cold war The geographical focus of the series is primarily Latin America the Caribbean Southern and Eastern Europe and relevant experiences in Africa and Asia The series editor is Laurence Whitehead Senior Research Fellow Nuffield College University of Oxford *United Nations Peacekeeping and the Politics of Authoritarianism* Sarah von Billerbeck, Birte Julia Gippert, Kseniya Oksamytna, Oisín Tansey, 2025-01-11 What impact does UN

peacekeeping have on the politics of authoritarianism in host countries This book advances a theoretically innovative and empirically rich answer to this question while the UN does not intentionally promote authoritarianism it faces a number of constraints and dilemmas that give rise to what we call authoritarian enabling Enabling can occur through two mechanisms capacity building and the creation of a permissive environment which enhance the ability of host governments to engage in authoritarian behavior and signal to them that doing so is low cost This book illustrates these two mechanisms with four in depth case studies of UN peacekeeping operations UNTAC in Cambodia MONUC MONUSCO in the Democratic Republic of Congo MINUSTAH in Haiti and UNMIL in Liberia The analysis is based on primary interview data from over 200 interviews The authors explore the sources of enabling identifying the trade offs and contradictions that give rise to these two mechanisms They include respect for sovereignty the importance of working relations with the host government the tension between democracy and other mission goals the pressure to demonstrate quick results and divergences within missions and the broader international community While enabling stops short of the outright promotion of authoritarianism it explains why the UN s activities often appear to contradict its stated objectives and the outcomes it delivers fall short of its goals In addition to its theoretical and empirical contributions the book suggests how these dilemmas and challenges can be overcome

going to play a large part in the uprisings themselves as well as the ensuing political and social changes In this book Nadine Sika demonstrates how youth movements initiated contestation and how the regime in Egypt reacted through a display of authoritarian resilience creating opportunities threats to and constraints on the ability of youth movements to mobilize and to network On the other hand she explores how youth movement s repertoires can cause a regime to adapt upgrade or downgrade its authoritarian tools in an attempt to control co opt or disempower the movement highlighting how a regime s perception of a threat can propel it towards either defensive or offensive strategies *Elites and Arab Politics* Ian Kelly,2020-06-11 This work explains elite behaviour in authoritarian systems and proposes why elites withdraw their support for the incumbent when faced with popular uprisings Building upon foundations drawn from institutional authoritarianism and synthesised with local context from the substantial scholarship on the Middle East and North Africa the book argues that the elite supporting autocrats come from three distinct cadres the military the single party and the personalist Each of these cadres possesses its own distinct institutional interests and preferences towards regime change Drawing on these interests the study constructs a theoretical framework that is assessed through testing it against three variables Utilising an analytic narrative the research finds that the withdrawal of elite support is the consequence of long term processes that see distinct cadres marginalised First increased incumbent preference for personalist elements destabilises regimes as the military and single party cadres reconsider their positions Second neoliberal economic policies implemented via structural adjustment accelerated this personalisation as the state s withdrawal from the economy This in turn affected the ability of the military and single party elites to access patronage Finally the degree of military involvement in the formal political sphere contributes to shaping the nature of the system that replaced the incumbent regime under examination Building upon a wide range of literature the book argues that interest realisation determines whether or not elite actors support regime change in authoritarian systems The volume will be of interest to scholars researching politics social sciences and the Middle East
