OLIVIA O'RYAN

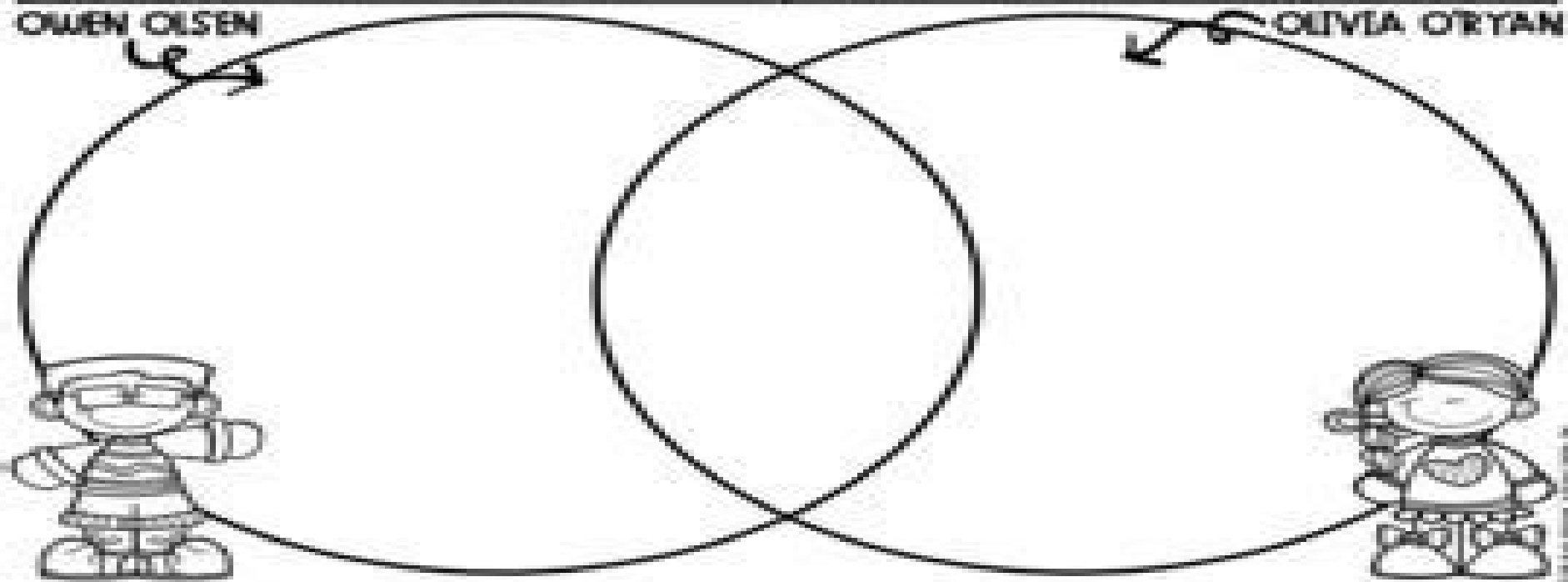
