Some people have trouble getting around because of physical challenges. These challenges might mean people use wheelchairs, walkers, or crutches. It can be hard for them to go places safely on their own.



Others have sensory challenges like having trouble hearing or seeing. This can make reading or watching TV tricky. They might also have trouble hearing sounds like alarms and doorbells.
