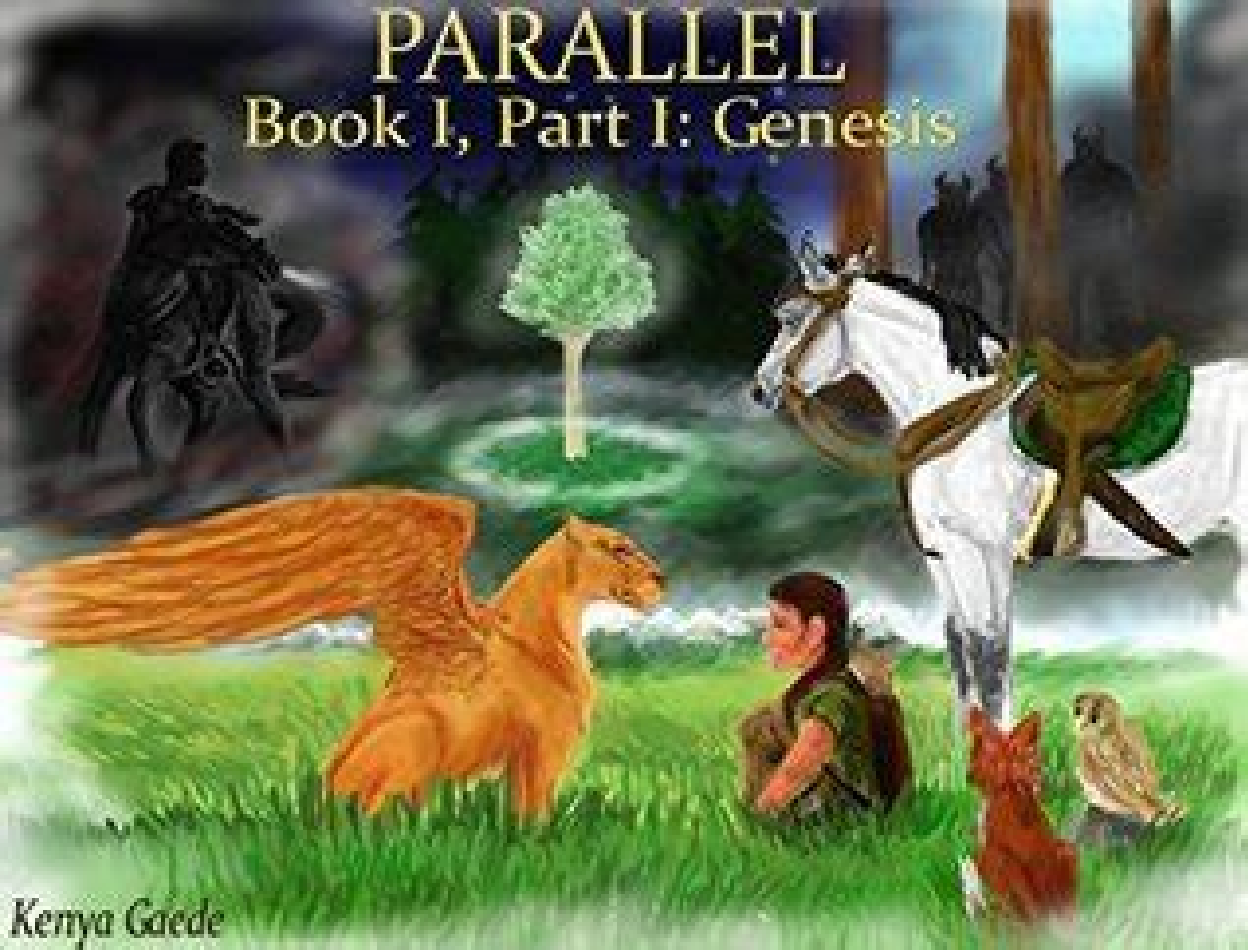

Rabbi Goldberg should mirror the many ways God enters into the human experience Offering philosophic inquiry personal reflection and fresh exegesis plus a touch of poetry humor and storytelling God Spoke Once I Heard Twice is a brilliant learned and inspired contribution to an ongoing chronicle of faith

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
