The Reading Report Card, 1971-88 Ina V. S. Mullis, Lynn Jenkins, National Assessment of Educational Progress (Project), 1990 Intended to serve as a resource for the many and varied groups concerned with improving students reading proficiencies this report from the Nation's Report Card provides a long term perspective on students reading skills and strategies based on a series of five national assessments conducted from 1971 to 1988 Each chapter of the report provides a different perspective on trends in students reading abilities.
