ORIGINS OF THE MUTAPA STATE.

Brach who haves his argument on the following massers.

- He argues that Shona Kings were highly respected and so were their sons. So how could a regul descended be send on a salt expedition.

The arguments of Beach hold much water in refinting the credibility of the salt expedition throny. Nevertheless one wishes to highlight that those arguments of Beach are dressed with weaknesses, freecosts, and far first-hed.
