The Letter from Prison W. Clark Gilpin, 2024-06-24 Letters from prison testifying to deeply felt ethical principles have a long history extending from antiquity to the present day In the early modern era the rise of printing houses helped turn these letters into a powerful form of political and religious resistance W Clark Gilpin s fascinating book examines how letter writers in England ranging from archbishops to Quaker women consolidated the prison letter as a literary form Drawing from a large collection of printed prison letters written from the reign of Henry VIII to the closing decades of the seventeenth century Gilpin explores the genre s many facets within evolving contexts of reformation and revolution The writers of these letters portrayed the prisoner of conscience as a distinct persona and the prison as a place of redemptive suffering where bearing witness had the power to change society The Letter from Prison features a diverse cast of characters and a literary genre that combines drama and inspiration It is sure to appeal to those interested in early modern England prison literature and cultural forms of resistance

Education and Skills Committee, 2005 In light of the transfer of responsibility for prison education to the Department for Education and Skills DfES the Committee s report examines the provision of education and training in prisons including the overall strategy for prison education delivery structures at national regional and local levels programme contents in comparison to external standards and barriers to delivery across the wider prison regime Findings include that current provision is unacceptable in terms of quantity and quality of provision and a fundamental shift in approach is required Although there has been an increase in resources available in 2004 on average only a third of prisoners had access to prison education at any one time The Committee highlights the need for an overarching strategy and higher priority to be given to prison education based on recognition of its role in helping to reduce recidivism through rehabilitation and suited to meet the needs of individual prisoners to ensure they have a real alternative to crime on release

Education in Prison Emma Hughes, 2016-04-29 The role of education in prisons prisoners decisions regarding education the impact of prison culture on either encouraging or discouraging such activities and the potential consequences of education for prisoners reentry into society all have important implications This extended analysis of prisoner education represents a unique contribution to an under researched field whilst also making important and original connections between research on education in prison and the literature on adult learning in the community Through offering crucial insights into the varied motivations and disincentives that inform prisoners decisions to study in prison whether it be through distance learning or prison based classes the reader is also able to consider factors that inform decisions to engage in a broader range of positive and constructive activities whilst in prison These research findings provide insight into how prison culture and

prison policies may impact upon rehabilitative endeavour and suggest ways in which prisons may seek to encourage constructive and or rehabilitative activities amongst their inhabitants if desired Based on interviews and questionnaires completed by British adult prisoners studying through distance learning this qualitative study offers a valuable complement and counterpart to prison education studies that focus on measuring recidivism rates The learner centred approach used yields a nuanced and complex understanding of the varied ways in which education in prison actually operates and is experienced and considers the consequences of this for the students lives As such the findings offer further insight into important evidence resulting from recidivism studies reviewed within the book whilst contributing to the reemerging interest in studies of prison life and prison culture that are based on prisoner interviews

Prison Town Andrea R. Morrell, 2025-06
 Elmira a town of about twenty six thousand people in central New York is in some ways a typical town with quiet tree lined residential streets an art museum local coffee shops and a small college The city however is best known as home to Elmira Correctional Facility and until its closure in March 2022 the Southport Correctional Facility Hundreds of locals have worked at the prisons the town plays host to visitors of the incarcerated and local medical institutions provide treatment to prisoners The prisons and Elmira are inseparable In *Prison Town* Andrea R Morrell illustrates the converging and shifting fault lines of race and class through a portrait of a prison town undergoing deindustrialization as it chooses the path of prison expansion In this ethnography Morrell highlights the contradictions of prison work as work that allows a middle class salary and lifestyle but trades in other forms of stigma Guards prisoners prisoners families and meager amounts of money and care work travel through spaces of free and unfree via the porous borders between prison and town As Morrell captures the rapid expansion of the carceral state into upstate New York from the perspective of a small city with two prisons she demonstrates how the prison system s racialized gendered and classed dispossession has crossed its own porous borders into the city of Elmira
