Kiser, 2018-08-09 Following Zebulon Pike s expeditions in the early nineteenth century U S expansionists focused their gaze on the Southwest Explorers traders settlers boundary adjudicators railway surveyors and the U S Army crossed into and through New Mexico transforming it into a battleground for competing influences determined to control the region Previous histories have treated the Santa Fe trade the American occupation under Colonel Stephen W Kearny the antebellum Indian Wars debates over slavery the Pacific Railway and the Confederate invasion during the Civil War as separate events in New Mexico In *Coast to Coast Empire* William S Kiser demonstrates instead that these developments were interconnected parts of a process by which the United States effected the political economic and ideological transformation of the region New Mexico was an early proving ground for Manifest Destiny the belief that U S possession of the entire North American continent was inevitable Kiser shows that the federal government s military commitment to the territory stemmed from its importance to U S expansion Americans wanted California but in order to retain possession of it and realize its full economic and geopolitical potential they needed New Mexico as a connecting thoroughfare in their nation building project The use of armed force to realize this claim fundamentally altered New Mexico and the Southwest Soldiers marched into the territory at the onset of the Mexican American War and occupied it continuously through the 1890s leaving an indelible imprint on the region s social cultural political judicial and economic systems By focusing on the activities of a standing army in a civilian setting Kiser reshapes the history of the Southwest underlining the role of the military not just in obtaining territory but in retaining it

for Americans how the canning industry emerged from the Civil War the difference between Americans and people of other countries in terms of what percentage of their income is spent on food and beverages and how taxation on beverages like tea rum and whisky set off important political rebellions in U S history Crossings Frances Levine,2024-12-12 The Santa Fe Trail has a special allure in southwestern history it was a road of lucrative commerce military expansion and great adventure Because these themes are connected with the Santa Fe Trail in the American imagination however the trail is not often associated with stories of women Crossings tells the personal stories of several women who made the journey showing how they were involved with and affected by Santa Fe Trail trade The Santa Fe Trail was a nexus of nations and cultures connecting the northern frontier of newly formed Mexico with the quickly expanding western United States as well as with the many Indigenous nations whose traditional lands it crossed With her attention on women Frances Levine enriches our understanding of the Santa Fe Trail and shows how interregional trade affected society politics and culture Through diaries letters and firsthand accounts Levine seeks to understand the experiences of women who journeyed from St Louis to Santa Fe as well as some who made an eastward crossing Crossings focuses on women who traveled during the most crucial period of Santa Fe Trail trade from the early 1820s to the later 1870s ending as railroads made cross continental movement a safer and more leisurely experience for travelers Several of the women made multiple crossings adding to the depth of their observations of the changing country and dispelling the myth of women in this period as averse to the risks of trail life Crossings introduces readers to the stories of women such as the Comanche captive Mar a Rosa Villalpando Carmel Benavides Robidoux and Kit Carson s half Arapaho daughter Adaline both of whose lives were dramatically impacted by American expansion suffragist Julia Anna Archibald Holmes Kate Messervy Kingsbury who sought health on the trail west diarist Susan Shelby Magoffin and her enslaved servant Jane army wife Anna Maria De Camp Morris Jewish pioneers Betty and Flora Spiegelberg and many others As an expert guide to the people of the Santa Fe Trail Frances Levine has curated a view of the American West that gives voice to many of the women who made this journey **America** Steven E.

Devotion to the Adopted Country Tyler V. Johnson, 2012-06-29 In Devotion to the Adopted Country Tyler V Johnson looks at the efforts of America s Democratic Party and Catholic leadership to use the service of immigrant volunteers in the U S Mexican War as a weapon against nativism and anti Catholicism Each chapter focuses on one of the five major events or issues that arose during the war finishing with how the Catholic and immigrant community remembered the war during the nativist resurgence of the 1850s and in the outbreak of the Civil War Johnson s book uncovers a new social aspect to military history by connecting the war to the larger social political and religious threads of antebellum history Having grown used to the repeated attacks of nativists upon the fidelity and competency of the German and Irish immigrants flooding into the United States Democratic and Catholic newspapers vigorously defended the adopted citizens they valued as constituents and congregants These efforts frequently consisted of arguments extolling the American virtues of the recent arrivals pointing to their hard work love of liberty and willingness to sacrifice for their adopted country However immigrants sometimes undermined this portrayal by prioritizing their ethnic and or religious identities over their identities as new U S citizens Even opportunities seemingly tailor made for the defenders of Catholicism and the nation s adopted citizens could go awry When the supposedly well disciplined Irish volunteers from Savannah brawled with soldiers from another Georgia company on a Rio Grande steamboat the fight threatened to confirm the worst stereotypes of the nation s new Irish citizens In addition although the Jesuits John McElroy and Anthony Rey gained admirers in the army and in the rest of the country for their untiring care for wounded and sick soldiers in northern Mexico anti Catholic activists denounced them for taking advantage of vulnerable young men to win converts for the Church Using the letters and personal papers of soldiers the diaries and correspondence of Fathers McElroy and Rey Catholic and Democratic newspapers and military records Johnson

illuminates the lives and actions of Catholic and immigrant volunteers and the debates over their participation in the war Shedding light on this understudied and misunderstood facet of the war with Mexico Devotion to the Adopted Country adds to the scholarship on immigration and religion in antebellum America illustrating the contentious and controversial process by which immigrants and their supporters tried to carve out a place in U S society **Trails of Historic New Mexico** Hunt Janin,Ursula Carlson,2014-11-21 This is a survey of the major historic trails of New Mexico and other parts of the American Southwest These trails were used by Indians prospectors soldiers buffalo hunters immigrants and cattle and sheep drovers and unlike other more famous Western trails were used as a network of two way trade routes instead of one way avenues for westward migration Introductory chapters highlight prehistoric Indian trails Spanish exploration and Pecos as a microcosm of the old Southwest Each subsequent chapter covers an individual trail describing its history and some of the people who used it A chronology of New Mexico s history and trail system is included as are maps of the most important trails

Heidler,2005-11-30 Victory over Mexico added vast western territories to America but it also quickened the domestic slavery debate and crippled Mexico for decades making the Mexican War one of our most ambiguous conflicts Primary documents biographical sketches and narrative chapters rounded out by twenty images and maps and a robust bibliography and index make this work by two of America s foremost Antebellum historians a must have to understand one of our most contentious episodes The United States went to war with Mexico in the spring of 1846 and by the fall of 1847 American soldiers were walking in the streets of Mexico City The following February Mexico was forced to sign the Treaty of Guadalupe Hidalgo that ceded what became the U S Southwest and Pacific Coast Rather than an isolated episode the war

was the culmination of a series of events that began before Mexican independence and included treaty arrangements with Spain the revolt of Mexico's northern province of Texas and the growing discord over American reactions to Texan independence The legacy of the war was dire for both countries The victorious United States commenced a bitter argument over the fate of slavery in the territories acquired from Mexico that eventually culminated in southern secession and Civil War Defeated Mexico coped for decades with a ruined economy and a broken political system while nursing a grudge against the Colossus of the North This book examines these events from both the American and Mexican perspectives Topics covered include succinct histories of the American and Mexican Republics from their colonial founding to their independence from European countries The problems over Texas including Anglo immigration the Texas Revolution and the controversies surrounding U S annexation of Texas the crises instigated by American annexation of Texas brought on by the crossed purposes of American expansionist aims and domestic concerns over slavery the northern campaigns of the war in California and New Mexico Winfield Scott's amphibious landing and siege at Vera Cruz and his epic march to Mexico City and the collapse of the Mexican government and finally the crafting of the peace treaty and the bitter legacies of the war for both the U S and Mexico Biographical sketches of Valentin Gomez Farias Jose Joaquin de Herrera Sam Houston Stephen Watts Kearny President James Polk and other notable figures of the event provide firsthand glimpses into the motivations of the key players Nine maps eleven images a detailed chronology and a dozen vital annotated primary documents add considerable depth to the book An extensive annotated biography and robust index complete this valuable new edition on one of Young America's most trying and contentious periods
