Revit checklist

- Import Construction drawings into AutoCad and prepare separate cad files for each of the floors, elevations and roof.
- 2. Open a new project using the imperial architectural template.
- 3. Set the levels as per the elevations in the construction drawings and labelling them the same.
- Import the floor plan views onto Revit and place the drawing at origin in between the four preset building elevations and scale accordingly.
- Duplicate generic walls to create all necessary walls according to thickness, as well as creating separate walls for the interior and exterior walls.
- 6. Set baseboard profiles for all interior walls.
- Create duplicates of generic floors to create separate floors for the Baths, Patios, porch, lawn and drive/walkway.
- Draw order per floor Exterior walls, interior walls, doors and windows (as per sill level specified in the plan modelling any if necessary), stairs, ceilings, lights, floor.
- 9. Connect exteriors walls.
- Add finishes Exterior trims, wall finishes if any, paints and materials.
- 11. Create cabinetry as shown in the plan.
- 12. Add free standing furniture.
