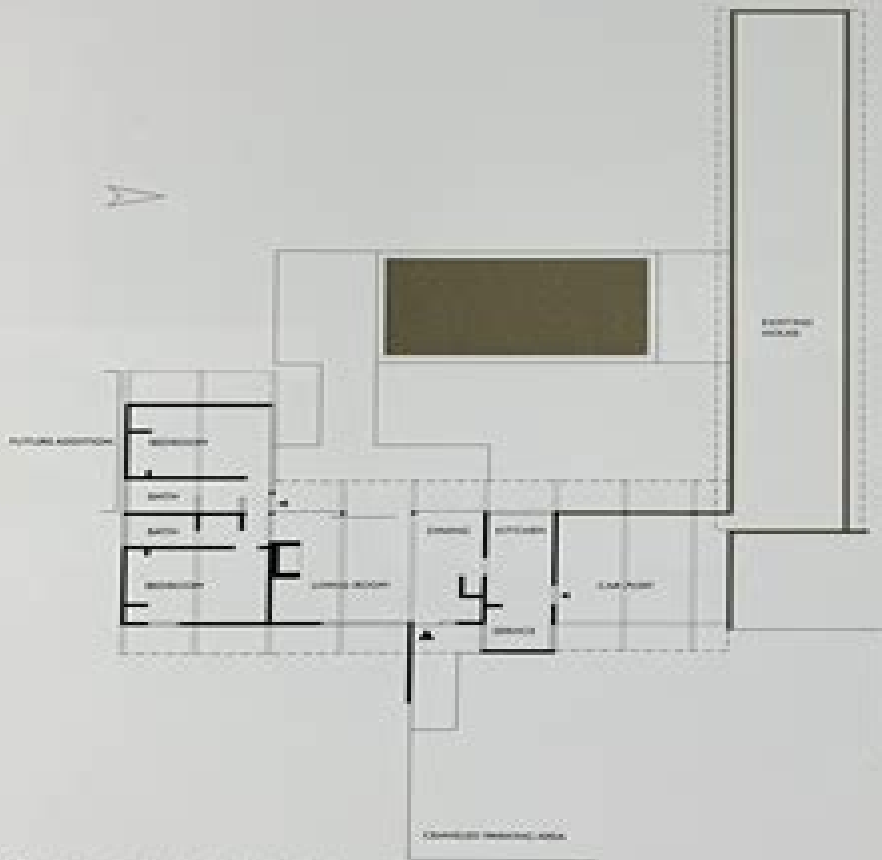

Though only 1,180 square feet, this one bedroom-and-study dwelling still had two entrances and a lively interaction with the outdoors in its redlines on the schematic design plans. Neutra switched the position of the sink and the stove so that the sink faced the windows and lovely views to the north. The single move, which also permitted the person at the sink to observe approaching visitors, thus addressed two biomimetic needs simultaneously: that of engaging the environment and that of empowering the owner to decide whether to "stay, fight or fly".
