interpretive chapters employ the most significant criticism from English Russian and French literary scholarship Dostoevsky s philosophical conception of man is compared and contrasted with the conception that Scheler and Heidegger hold i e that freedom is man s essence Sartre s atheistic humanism and Camus thought The following conclusions are consonant with Dostoevsky s work freedom is constitutive for the being or the mode of being essence of man it is an inalienable duty one must become oneself Man strives to overcome himself and to exceed his freedom but in so doing invariably loses it Man exceeds himself only in the sense that he realizes an ideal human possibility The Dostoevskian man reveals not only the absence of human nature but also the enormous power which man possesses for achieving his ideal human possibility
