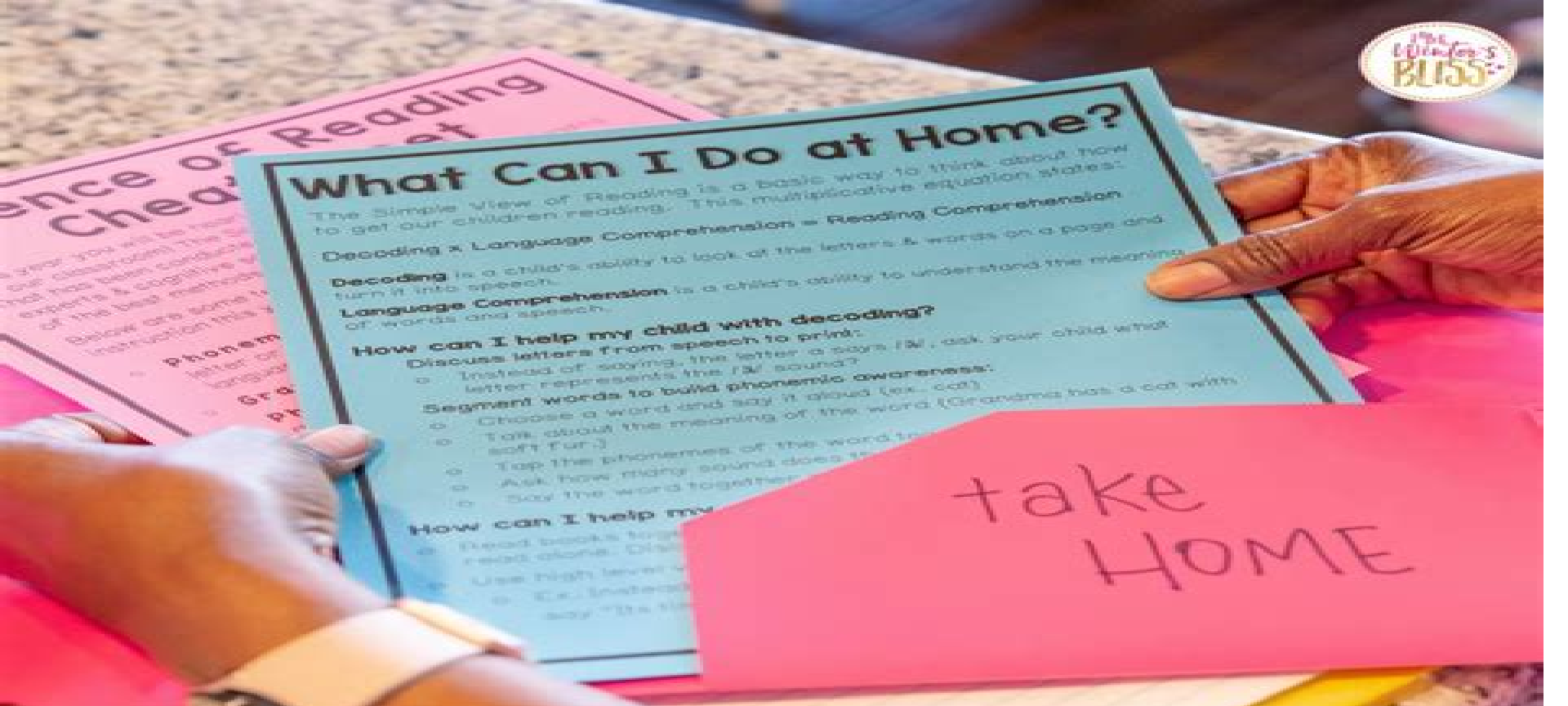




What Can I Do at Home?

The Simple View of Reading is a basic way to think about how to get our children reading. This multiplicative equation states:

Decoding x Language Comprehension = Reading Comprehension

Decoding is a child's ability to look at the letters & words on a page and turn it into speech.

Language Comprehension is a child's ability to understand the meaning of words and speech.

How can I help my child with decoding?

Discuss letters from speech to print:

- o Instead of saying, the letter a says /a/, ask your child what letter represents the /a/ sound?

Segment words to build phonemic awareness:

- o Choose a word and say it aloud (ex. cat)
- o Talk about the meaning of the word (Grandma has a cat with soft fur.)
- o Tap the phonemes of the word to
- o Ask how many sound does it
- o Say the word together
