

Science Project Outline: Research Paper

I. Title Page

The title page should include the title of your paper, your name, and maybe a picture. See the other side of this sheet for an example.

II. Introduction Paragraph

1. An introduction to your general topic (4-5 sentences). Use our recipe for introductions: define your topic, provide a little background information (real general, everyday-knowledge-type info. about your topic), answer the question. Remember, the question is your question!

III. Content (the body)

1. In this section, make sure you provide background information necessary to understand your topic. This section should be at least two pages long, and should be very detailed and descriptive. Remember, your main goal is to provide a detailed answer to your question.

-Do not copy information word for word from a book or the internet-you should rewrite the information using your own words.

-Be sure to organize your information logically, and arrange it into paragraphs for easy reading.

2. The body should also include a paragraph or two about one scientist's contribution to the field of science you're discussing. Please include any discoveries, theories, or other contributions the scientist made/is making in his/her career.

IV. Conclusion Paragraph

1. Include a brief summary of the major points you've made in your paper. Be sure the answer to your question is included here (3-5 sentences).

2. Also include a personal comment. This might be any insight, advice, or opinions you have to share about your topic after researching it (2-3 sentences).

V. Works Cited List

Specific instructions for your bibliography will be provided on an additional handout.

VI. Additional Paper Requirements

-Your paper must be between 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ and 5 pages long (NOT including the title page and works cited page).

-Your paper must be typed, double-spaced, in 12 pt. font, with 1 $\frac{1}{2}$ inch margins.

-Be sure to include a title page and works cited page with at least five sources.

-Your paper must contain very few spelling or grammatical errors. Be sure to proofread and spell check it carefully!
