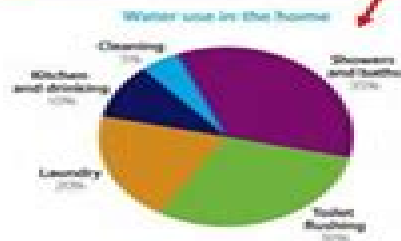
Home water use makes up a bout 5% of total water use worldwide.
