However, critics argue that the deterrence effect of the death penalty is inconclusive, citing studies that show no significant difference in crime rates between states with and without capital punishment. Nonetheless, the presence of the death penalty in legal systems continues to serve as a psychological deterrent, reinforcing societal norms against violent acts. Thus, while the debate over its deterrent effectiveness persists, the death penalty remains a significant tool for crime prevention in many parts of the world.
