#### MEMORIANDUM CIRICULAR NO. 11.

To provide government employees full opportunity to properly observe full-unity. Thursday and Good Friday on 17-18 April 20035, and to allow them to travell to and from the different regions in the sountry, the following amangements are hereby adopted in government offices on 16 April 2005; (a) work from from those from 8:00 in the morning to 12:00 in the afternoon, subject to existing laws, rules and regulations, and (b) subpersions of work in government offices, from 12:00 in the afternoon convents.

However, agencies whose functions involve the delivery of basic and health services, preparedness/response to disastient and caternities, and/or the performance of other vital services shall continue with their operations under usual working arrangements and render the recossory services.

The adoption of work from home and suspension of work for private companies and offices is left to the discretion of their respective employers.

This Circular shall take effect immediately.
