MEMORANDUM CIRCULAR NO. 81

To provide government employees full opportunity to properly observe Maundy Thursday and Good Friday on 17-18 April 2025, and to allow them to travel to and from the different regions in the country, the following arrangements are hereby adopted in government offices on 18 April 2025: (a) work from home from 8:00 in the morning to 12:00 in the afternoon, subject to existing laws, rules and regulations; and (b) suspension of work in government offices, from 12:00 in the afternoon onwards.

However, agencies whose functions involve the delivery of basic and health services, preparedness/response to disasters and calamities, and/or the performance of other vital services shall continue with their operations under usual working arrangements and render the necessary services.

The adoption of work from home and suspension of work for private companies and offices is left to the discretion of their respective employers.

This Circular shall take effect immediately.

Formality of the Little N -disks Operad Pascal Lambrechts, Ismar Volić, 2014-06-05 The little disks operad along with its variants is an important tool in homotopy theory It is defined in terms of configurations of disjoint dimensional disks inside the standard unit disk in $\mathbb{R}^n$ and it was initially conceived for detecting and understanding fold loop spaces Its many uses now stretch across a variety of disciplines including topology algebra and mathematical physics In this paper the authors develop the details of Kontsevich's proof of the formality of little disks operad over the field of real numbers More precisely one can consider the singular chains on as well as the singular homology of These two objects are operads in the category of chain complexes The formality then states that there is a zig zag of quasi isomorphisms connecting these two operads The formality also in some sense holds in the category of commutative differential graded algebras The authors additionally prove a relative version of the formality for the inclusion of the little disks operad in the little disks operad when $n \geq 2$

Access to Scientific Research David J. Disorder and the Disinformation Society Jonathan Paul Marshall, James Goodman, Didar Zowghi, Francesca da Rimini, 2015-04-17 This book is the first general social analysis that seriously considers the daily experience of information disruption and software failure within contemporary Western society Through an investigation of informationalism defined as a contemporary form of capitalism it describes the social processes producing informational disorder While most social theory sees disorder as secondary pathological or uninteresting this book takes disordering processes as central to social life The book engages with theories of information society which privilege information order offering a strong counterpoint centred on disinformation Disorder and the Disinformation Society offers a practical agenda arguing that difficulties in producing software are both inherent to the process of developing software and in the social dynamics of informationalism It outlines the dynamics of software failure as they impinge on of information workers and on daily life explores why computerized finance has become inherently self disruptive asks how digital enclosure and intellectual property create conflicts over cultural creativity and disrupt informational accuracy and scholarship and reveals how social media can extend but also distort the development of social movements

Numerical Approximations of Stochastic Differential Equations with Non-Globally Lipschitz Continuous Coefficients Martin Hutzenthaler, Arnulf Jentzen, 2015-06-26 Many stochastic differential equations SDEs in the literature have a superlinearly growing nonlinearity in their drift or diffusion coefficient Unfortunately moments of the computationally efficient Euler Maruyama approximation

method diverge for these SDEs in finite time This article develops a general theory based on rare events for studying integrability properties such as moment bounds for discrete time stochastic processes Using this approach the authors establish moment bounds for fully and partially drift implicit Euler methods and for a class of new explicit approximation methods which require only a few more arithmetical operations than the Euler Maruyama method These moment bounds are then used to prove strong convergence of the proposed schemes Finally the authors illustrate their results for several SDEs from finance physics biology and chemistry

The Fourier Transform for Certain HyperKähler Fourfolds Mingmin Shen, Charles Vial, 2016-03-10 Using a codimension 1 algebraic cycle obtained from the Poincaré line bundle Beauville defined the Fourier transform on the Chow groups of an abelian variety A and showed that the Fourier transform induces a decomposition of the Chow ring $CH^*(A)$ By using a codimension 2 algebraic cycle representing the Beauville–Bogomolov class the authors give evidence for the existence of a similar decomposition for the Chow ring of Hyperkähler varieties deformation equivalent to the Hilbert scheme of length 2 subschemes on a K3 surface They indeed establish the existence of such a decomposition for the Hilbert scheme of length 2 subschemes on a K3 surface and for the variety of lines on a very general cubic fourfold
