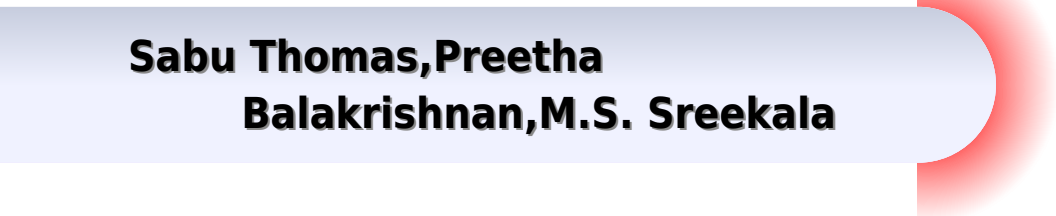

At the last NATO ASI on liquids held in Corsica August 1977 Professor de Gennes in his summary of that meeting suggested that the next ASI should concentrate on some specific aspect of the subject and mentioned explicitly ionic solutions as one possibility. The challenge was taken up by Marie Claire Bellissent Funel and George Neilson. I am sure that all the participants would wish to congratulate our two colleagues for putting together an outstanding programme of lectures, round tables and poster session.
