

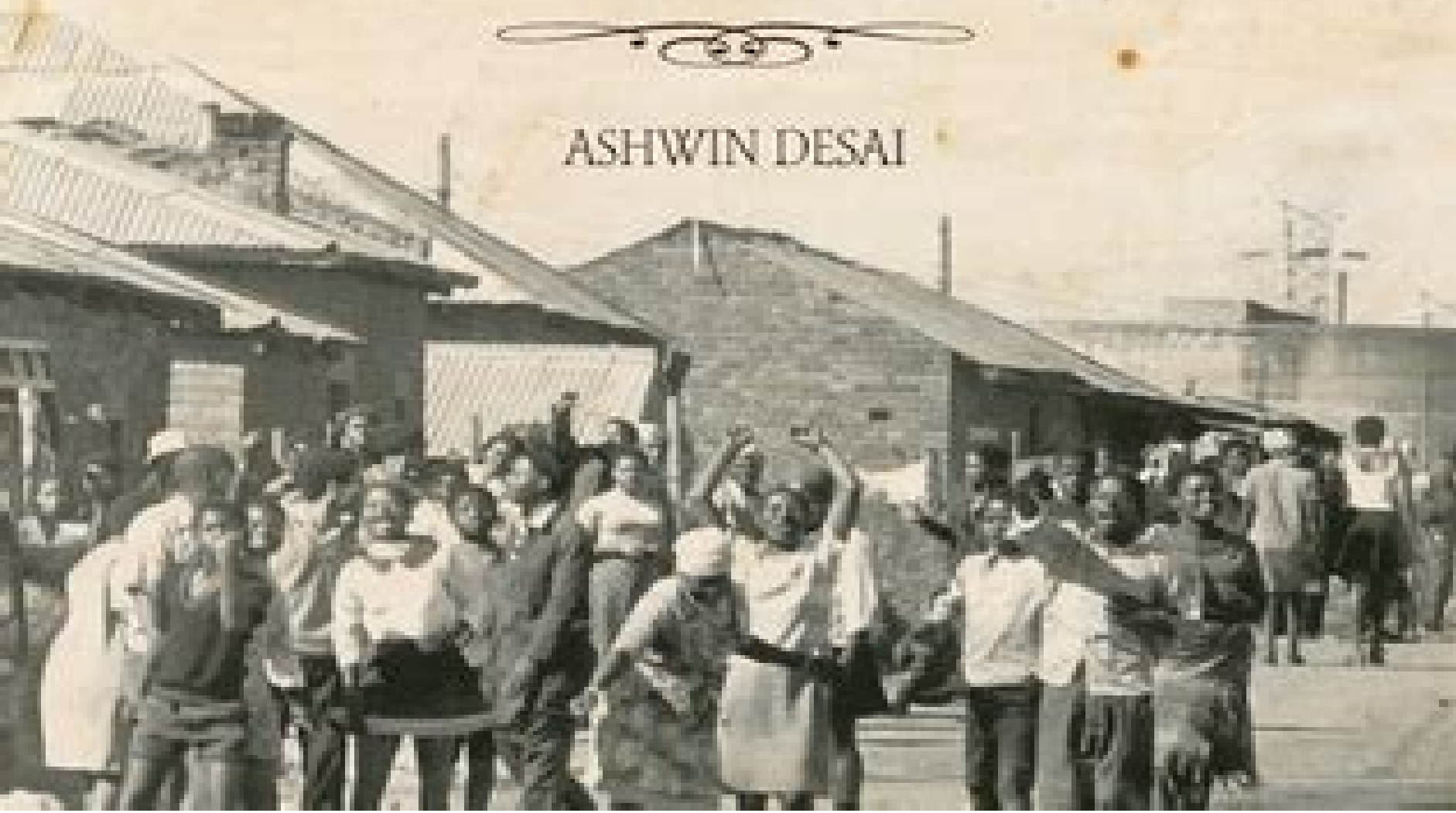

Reading Revolution Shakespeare On Robben Island:

Reading Revolution Ashwin Desai, 2012 The prison authorities on South Africa's Robben Island displayed a remarkable obsession with censoring the news that prisoners could receive from the outside world Yet as the pages of this book reveal political prisoners managed to escape these constraints through literature travelling to the sites of contemporary revolutionary struggles and to the frontlines of the French and Bolshevik revolutions Tolstoy jostled with Trotsky while Shakespeare winged his way over the walls of the single and communal cells As the prisoners brought their experiences to bear on the text the works of Shakespeare were mined for their anti colonial and anti apartheid inspirations as much as for the power and beauty of their words The texts also left their mark on the consciousness and memories of liberation fighters with many prisoners still reciting lines from Shakespeare's plays and sonnets some three decades after their release Through the memories and biographical accounts written by former political inmates the book evocatively brings to life the voices of prisoners who furtively copied books at night before they were snatched back by the prison guards *Reading Revolution* is about how words can inspire the human spirit light up the intellect and free the reader to travel the world But this is not a book simply about the past By opening the all too quickly forgotten pages of history the book seeks to ignite once more a reading revolution to stir up the imagination in a South Africa whose democratic transition seeks to consolidate power from above while being increasingly contested by insurgent protest from below

The Robben Island Shakespeare Matthew Hahn, 2017-01-12 During the Apartheid years in South Africa a copy of *The Complete Works of William Shakespeare* was smuggled around the prison on Robben Island The book's significance resides in the fact that the book's owner Sonny Venkatratham passed it to a number of his fellow political prisoners in the single cells including Nelson Mandela asking them to mark their favourite passages with a signature and date Informally known as the Robben Island Bible numerous prisoners selected the speeches that meant the most to them and their experience as political prisoners In 2008 and 2010 playwright and scholar Matthew Hahn conducted interviews with eight former political prisoners in South Africa Offering a vivid and startling account of the experience of these political prisoners during Apartheid this extraordinary verbatim play weaves Shakespeare's words together with first hand accounts from these men They offer their reflections on their time as Liberation activists and twenty years later on the costs consequences and whether or not it was all worth it The play is published alongside a preface by Sonny Venkatratham and an introduction by South African actor director playwright and cultural activist John Kani

Dying for Freedom Jacob Dlamini, 2024-07-09 What happens when death becomes the ultimate marker of one's commitment to one's freedom? What happens when the opposite of freedom is not unfreedom but death, not slavery but mortality? How are we to think of the right to life when a political demand for dignity and honor might be more important than life itself? *Dying for Freedom* explores these questions by drawing on archival evidence from South Africa to show how death and conflicting notions of sacrifice dominated the struggle for political equality in that country. This investment generated a notion of political sacrifice so absolute that anything less than death was rendered suspect. More importantly, it resulted in a hierarchy of death whereby some deaths were more important than others and where some deaths could be mourned and others not. This highly original account of the necropolitics of the liberation struggle will be of interest to students and scholars throughout the humanities and social sciences and to anyone interested in South Africa.
