What is a context?

- A context is the words that come just before or after a word or phrase. It helps you to understand its meaning.
- Context can be a sentence or paragraph or a text.
- It helps you make a general prediction about the meaning.

What is a context clue?

A context clue is a fact or an idea and it suggests the meaning of the unknown word.

- Sometimes you can guess the meaning from *the other words in the same sentence*.

Example: Some of the trees in the Redwood National Park are very **gargantuan**, and in fact they are the *tallest* trees in the world.

From the expression the tallest trees we can understand that gargantuan means very large, big or huge (something similar to this). Do not forget that you are just trying to guess the meaning, not a dictionary definition!

- Sometimes you need to read several sentences before and / or after the unknown word.

Example:

It rained heavily last night and the window was open during the storm. The papers on my desk were a **soggy** mess.

We picked up the **soggy** towels and put them all in the garden in the sun to dry.

In the first sentence the context "*It rained heavily last night and the window was open during the storm*" helped us. In the second sentence "put them all in the garden in the sun to dry" helped us to guess the meaning of soggy.

From this context we can guess that soggy means very wet.
