Family Firms in Postwar Britain and Germany David Paulson,2023 Examines the culture and conduct of six small and medium sized enterprises SMEs in England and West Germany from 1945 to the late 1970s drawing on numerous archives in Germany and Britain This is the first book length study that examines the detailed histories of SMEs in a comparative transnational manner Emerging from this study is an evaluation of German and British varieties of capitalism in action showing that they were not fixed or static but rather have changed considerably as they evolved over time The German companies studied formed part of the Mittelstand the family owned sector which is unique to German speaking countries This book explores whether the principles of a close identification with the surrounding region and a patriarchal culture within a family atmosphere were adopted in practice then and whether they are still applicable today Paulson compares the Mittelstand to British SMEs in order to understand how their approach differed from that of their German counterparts For both countries the ecosystem which surrounded businesses is examined paying particular attention to funding and vocational education The book concludes that the potential for a British Mittelstand existed but that British companies were often less well managed and had to operate within a less supportive external environment than that which favoured the Mittelstand Historical lessons learned from the management of these companies still resonate today and can help us to understand contemporary differences in business performance This book will therefore be of interest to scholars and students of twentieth century business and economic history as well as management studies

Holocaust Memory and National Museums in Britain Emily-Jayne Stiles,2021-11-16 This book explores the Holocaust exhibition opened within the Imperial War Museum IWM in 2000 setting out the long and often contentious debates surrounding the conception design and finally the opening of an important exhibition within a national museum in Britain It considers a process of memory making through an assessment of Holocaust photographs material culture and survivor testimonies exploring theories of cultural memory as they apply to the national museum context Anchored in time and place the Holocaust

exhibition within Britain's national museum of war is influenced by and reflects an international rise in Holocaust consciousness in the 1990s This book considers the construction of Holocaust memory in 1990s Britain providing a foundation for understanding current and future national memory projects Through all aspects of the display the Holocaust is presented as meaningful in terms of what it says about Nazism and what this in turn says about Britishness From the original debates surrounding the inclusion of a Holocaust gallery at the IWM to the acquisition of Holocaust artefacts that could act as concrete evidence of Nazi barbarity and criminality the Holocaust reaffirms an image of Britain that avoids critical self reflection despite raising uncomfortably close questions The various display elements are brought together to consider multiple strands of the Holocaust story as it is told by national museums in Britain

Coal in Modern Britain

The Secret History of UK Security Vetting from 1909 to the Present Daniel Lomas,2025-05-15 Using newly available government records private papers and documents obtained through Freedom of Information this book tells the secret story of UK security vetting from 1909 to the present Although Britain avoided American style red baiting and McCarthy like witch hunts successive UK governments have like their Five Eyes allies implemented security procedures to protect government defence and industry from so called subversives and fellow travellers Officially from 1948 the British government applied political tests to civil servants a process extended to character defects in the early 1950s with the introduction of positive vetting However an unofficial purge had taken place for much longer facing political backlashes as an infringement of civil liberties and suppression of free speech Although it s been argued that Britain s secret purge had little impact this study looks at the experiences of those removed from the secret state those LGBT and BAME individuals discriminated against by government and the impact of government policy generally while studying the responses of Ministers and civil servants to spy scandals and international events Drawing from newly released archival material Freedom of Information releases and interviews this book offers new insights into the scope of government security checks on civil servants defence contractors and armed forces personnel from Edwardian spy scares and the inter war period to the Cold War and present day

Cyber and the City Ashley Sweetman,2022-07-25 Cyber security is the greatest risk faced by financial institutions today a risk they have understood and managed for decades longer than is commonly understood Ever since the major London banks purchased their first computers in the early 1960s they have had to balance their dependence on those machines with the need to secure their operations and retain the trust of their customers Technological change in

the second half of the 20th century prompted British banks to reevaluate their function as trusted protectors of wealth. In the City of London, the capital's oldest area and historically its business and commerce hub, the colossal clearing banks employed newly commercialised electronic computers, the processing power of which could transform the highly clerical clearing and settlement process.
