Demonstrating Knowledge of Students

1. **Student Self-Reflections**
 - a. "My Report Card"- This has students reflect on their time at school. They must rate themselves on things like paying attention, following directions, making good choices, etc. This form also asks students to write down one thing I need to know about them, future goals, and what they enjoy/don't like about school.
 - b. Behavior reflection sheets
2. **Data Tracking to Guide Instruction**
 - a. Math data binders- Students have data binders that call for them to fill out how they feel about each individual standard before and after we learn it. Students also fill out their scores on the pre-test and post-test on a bar graph so they can look at their growth.
 - b. Chapter breakdowns- I have used the charts from GoMath! to create individual assessment sheets that I fill out at the end of each chapter for students. This allows me to see which students are missing and need more help with. I typically take students for at least the top two things that they need help on, and we work one-on-one or in small groups.
 - c. Reteach groups for certain skills and concepts
3. **Collecting Information about Students**
 - a. Parent conference survey- This is four questions about their students' time and experience in fifth grade so far.
 - b. Parent questionnaire and "All About Me"
 - c. Notes about individual students completed through observations, activities, and assessments
 - d. RTI notes on individual students' progress
 - e. Notes about an individual student's progress and habits throughout the year
 - f. Goals for an individual student in math and language
4. **Student Self-Assessments**
 - a. Learning objective exit slip for lessons
 - b. Twitter post
 - c. Writing self-assessment
 - d. Student grading rubric- This rubric was actually created by my students. They determined what was important for this final project. They are filling out these rubrics on their own to reflect on how they did.
 - e. "Rate your understanding" quick check in math notebook (Students identify their levels of understanding on a certain skill or concept.) This guides my instruction and reteach groups.
 1. Level 0- No clue! Help me. Level 1- I got the idea of it but I'm still lost. Level 2- I understand if I have examples or help from Miss Briggs. Level 3- I understand- I've got this. Level 4- I understand so well that I could teach someone.
