The Parting of the Ways Stephen Spence, 2004 This book seeks to inject into the general discussion of the Parting of the Ways of Judaism and Christianity the social realities of the separation of a particular Christian community and a particular Jewish community By drawing upon the literary and the historical data available concerning the church in Rome Spence seeks to discover when and how Christians came to see themselves as an identifiably distinct community His findings will surprise those who see the Parting of the Ways as a slow process He argues that although the parting was early it was not without its complications Drawing upon the work of Rodney Stark a sociologist of religion Spence suggests that within the church in Rome there was a struggle between those who saw the church as a Jewish sect and those who saw the church as a Roman cult a struggle already underway when the Apostle Paul wrote Romans This struggle however was not an even one because it was the cultists those for whom the church's primary social location was the pagans of Rome who held the positions of power over the numerically smaller sectarians who sought to maintain the church's primary identity as a Jewish sect acceptable within the synagogues of Rome

than the one customarily perceived perhaps a less familiar story but perhaps a more factual one The Ministry of Paul the Apostle represents a significant paradigm shift for understanding Paul s ministry which involves two major campaigns an ordered awareness of Paul s ministry as far as Illyricum a revision of Paul s Corinthian ministry an historical confirmation of visits to Jerusalem an appropriate ordering and reaffirmation of Paul s letters including Romans 16 as a letter to Ephesus In addition the current study offers a new paradigm for correlation between our sources of Paul s letters and the book of Acts with the development of an underlying source tradition behind Acts The reader is thus invited to participate in a significant re evaluation of Paul s ministry and a proposed solution to a long standing mystery of correlation between Paul s letters and Acts When one travels with Paul one engages in a voyage of discovery This book makes sense of the mystery of Paul s ministry which when properly understood becomes an illuminating foundational window of clarity for sorting out a bewildering multitude of theological formulations of the enigmas of Paul s thought It is through a thorough awareness of the ministry of Paul that one comes to appreciate the contextual nature and depth of Paul s theological thought One comes to a new appreciation of Paul s place in early Christianity relevant even for those who live in a post modern age

Paul and the Salvation of the Individual Gary W. Burnett, 2001-12-01 This book proposes that there was a lively sense of the individual self in persons in the Hellenistic world of the urban centres in which Paul lived and ministered whereby individualistic behaviour was not unknown and where individuals were not simply determined by their culture and the group of which they were a part

This is in contrast to many recent sociological approaches to the New Testament which emphasise the collective over the individual. Hence it is argued that the individual is a central feature of Paul's letter to the Romans. Three texts in the first eight chapters of Romans are examined to indicate Paul's concern with the salvation of the individual and not just with questions of a more collective nature to do with the identity of the people of God. This book challenges the very strong emphasis put upon the collective in recent approaches to Paul's letter to the Romans especially by sociologically based NT research but also within the wider body of Romans research. It suggests that it is possible to maintain that Paul was vitally interested in the salvation of the individual without having to revert to traditional Lutheran interpretations of the text.
