will provide a depth of knowledge that will come in good stead when problems arise I can especially recommend the chapter on exercise physiology When the reader has mastered the material presented in this chapter he has acquired a knowledge base so that he can become an expert in exercise testing equal to almost anyone Over the years I have been privileged to know several of the authors and have followed their publications Their contributions to our knowledge base in this field have been considerable Acquiring this book and becoming familiar with its contents will set you apart in the field of exercise testing
