The shift from oral to written tradition emphasizes how flexible these stories are, since they were changed to fit several audiences and settings. Greek and Roman mythology's examination of universal subjects that cut across time and culture helps to explain why it still intrigues. The conflicts between gods and humans, the search for heroism, and the results of hubris mirror basic features of human life. These tales probe the subtleties of morality, authority, and the interaction between fate and free will. The gods are profoundly human in their shortcomings and want, even if they are immortal and strong. Often driven by envy, passion, and the urge for control, Zeus, for example, epitomizes both absolute authority and human weakness. His contacts with people draw attention to the unstable balance of power and the consequences of challenging divine will. Rather than viewing Paul as dealing with two different religions, we see Paul working to position believing Jews and Gentiles in relationship to Israel's history with God, particularly as it finds its climax in Jesus Christ. Thus Paul utilizes the law-faith dichotomy not to describe two paths of salvation but to redefine the people of God in the new age as ethnically inclusive.
