Activities of Daily Living (ADLs)

ADLs are tasks we complete during our day to day life to meet our basic human needs. These activities include dressing, bathing, oral hygiene, toileting, hair care, bed mobility, and much more!

Physical Body

OT's will look at the functions of an individual's physical body to evaluate current skills while comparing them to the prior level of function, and/or the desired level of function.

Cognitive Skills

Additionally, OT's will look at an individual's function of the mind. Cognition is a necessary element to complete activities requiring executive functioning skills, such as sequencing, memory, attention, problem-solving, and much more!

Sensory Regulation

A major component of pediatric rehab is sensory regulation, which is the ability to integrate and adjust sensory input to help manage arousal levels, attention, and emotional responses. This is a crucial skill to change arousal levels to appropriately match the environment and activity.
