Environmental Challenges and Governance Sacchidananda Mukherjee, Debashis Chakraborty, 2015-03-02 The economies located in East South and Southeast Asia have witnessed an interesting growth sustainability trade off over the last decades. While growth considerations have paved ways for deepened ties with growing trade investment waves and increasing population pressure necessitated exploitation of hitherto unutilized natural resources, focus on environmental sustainability has been a recent consideration. Resurgent Resource Nationalism Mapungubwe Institute for Strategic Reflection (MISTRA), 2016-02-15 The period between 2001 and 2008 saw the longest commodities boom in recent history. Resource rich countries across the world developed more interest in the profits, control and ownership of their natural resources. South Africa which did not benefit much from the boom in commodity prices was nonetheless affected by the emergent resource nationalism trend and it became the focus of the governing party's 2010 National General Council which ultimately resulted in the constitution of a committee to review the country's policy and legislative framework regarding natural wealth beneath the soil. Although the resurgence of resource nationalism is a recent phenomenon, the idea of state intervention in the economy and the extractive sector in particular is not new. Resurgent Resource Nationalism is a qualitative study undertaken by MISTRA for SASOL Ltd that looks at the resurgence of resource nationalism over the past ten years. It discusses the concept of resource nationalism and its manifestation in public policy. It identifies the concerns, drivers and instruments through which resource nationalism is pursued by various mining jurisdictions across regions. It deliberately focuses more on the hydrocarbons sector in order to suit the target audience. The aim is to observe macro trends emerging in various regions of the world and explore how best private actors can respond to the various forms of resource nationalism. **The 2010 Pakistan Floods: Environmental and Economic Impact**, 2015-04-15 Pakistan is a developing country of the Monsoon Asia with dense concentration of population in the plain areas of the Indus and other rivers. Due to its unique geographical setting, it is prone to various natural disasters including floods. There is a whole trail of death and destruction left behind by devastating floods. But the 2010 floods

in the country were unprecedented because of their vast areal coverage loss of thousands of lives and large scale destruction This study is an analysis of the impact of the 2010 floods on the environment and economy of Pakistan The study begins with the environmental characteristics of the study area to understand the drainage water availability and flooding patterns in different parts of the country Then a study of the flood history of Pakistan has been undertaken to identify possible causes of floods rescue and management operations and preparedness for the future The immediate damage and losses to the environment and economy have been separately studied followed by the impact of the floods resulting from widespread damages to the different sectors of the economy and environment The study reveals that the floods had a severe impact on the habitat ecology and lives of thousands of animals in the country The actual impact on the environment was so vast and far reaching that it is difficult to comprehend and express it in numerical terms Therefore in the study it has also been argued that loss of buildings infrastructure and agriculture is actually a loss of environment All sectors of the economy were affected by the floods but agriculture housing and transport and communication sectors were severely hit and had brought the whole country to a standstill Rescue and rehabilitation efforts carried out with the help of international cooperation achieved some degree of success But for the future Pakistan has to take many physical organisational and technological measures to deal effectively with natural disasters including floods There are many lessons to be learnt from the disastrous 2010 floods and hopefully this study will be useful in that direction
