Expressly concerned with literary embodiments of belief systems in post colonial cultures particularly West African religions in the Caribbean and Hinduism on the Indian subcontinent these essays also share a sense of Christianity as the pervasive presence of an ideological rhetoric among the economic social and political dimensions of imperialism In a polemical Afterword the editor argues that modes of reading religion and literature in post colonial cultures are characterised by a theodical preoccupation with a praxis of equity
