Fearful Symmetry Northrop Frye, 2013-04-04 This brilliant outline of Blake's thought and commentary on his poetry comes on the crest of the current interest in Blake and carries us further towards an understanding of his work than any previous study. The first section of the book shows how Blake arrived at a theory of knowledge that was also for him a theory of religion, of human life and of art, and how this rigorously defined system of ideas found expression in the complicated but consistent symbolism of his poetry. The second and third parts, after indicating the relation of Blake to English literature and the intellectual atmosphere of his own time, explain the meaning of Blake's poems and the significance of their characters.

Northrop Frye on Myth Ford Russell, 2021-10-28 Northrop Frye differed from other theorists of myth in tracing all of the major literary genres: romance, comedy, satire, not just tragedy, to myth and ritual. This volume is the most thorough presentation of his thinking on the subject.

The Reception of Northrop Frye, 2021-08-31 The widespread opinion is that Northrop Frye's influence reached its zenith in the 1960s and 1970s, after which point he became obsolete, his work buried in obscurity. This almost universal opinion is summed up in Terry Eagleton's 1983 rhetorical question: "Who now reads Frye?" In *The Reception of Northrop Frye*, Robert D. Denham catalogues what has been written about Frye: books, articles, translations, dissertations, and theses, and reviews, in order to demonstrate that the attention Frye's work has received from the beginning has progressed at a geomantic rate. Denham also explores what we can discover once we have a fairly complete record of Frye's reception in front of us, such as Hayden White's theory of emplotments applied to historical writing and Byron Almon's theory of musical narrative. The sheer quantity of what has been written about Frye reveals that the only valid response to Eagleton's rhetorical question is a very large and growing number, the growth being not incremental but exponential.

The Ethos of Rhetoric Michael J. Hyde, 2004 Fourteen noted rhetorical theorists and critics answer a summons to return ethics from abstraction to the particular. They discuss and explore a meaning of ethos that predates its more familiar translation as moral character and ethics. Together, the contributors define ethical discourse and describe what its practice looks like in particular communities.
