## Newton's First Law: The Law of Inertia

*"An object at rest stays at rest, and an object in motion stays in motion with the same speed and in the same direction unless acted upon by an unbalanced external force."*

### Breaking It Down

For instance, a book lying on a table will remain still until someone pushes it. Similarly, a rolling ball will continue moving in a straight line at constant speed unless friction or another force slows it down.

Have you ever wondered why wearing a seatbelt is so important? When a car suddenly stops (due to braking or collision), your body wants to keep moving forward because of inertia. The seatbelt provides the external force needed to stop your forward motion safely. Without it, your body would continue moving and possibly hit the dashboard.
