

Oeuvres tome 15 Jean Jaurès, 2023-11-29. Guerre la guerre est le dernier tome parmi les œuvres de Jean Jaurès. Il concerne une période particulièrement dramatique qui se tend du 1er octobre 1912 jusqu'au 31 juillet 1914, date de l'assassinat de Jaurès et veille du déclenchement de la Première Guerre mondiale. Il reprend le titre choisi par l'Internationale l'issue de son congrès de Berlin pour son appel à la mobilisation contre le danger de guerre. Est-il possible de circonscrire les conflits qui ravagent les Balkans et de trouver des solutions pacifiques aux fortes tensions qui opposent entre elles les puissances européennes ? De grands rassemblements à Paris et dans les autres capitales européennes des rencontres parlementaires à Berlin comme Berne des tentatives de coordination au sein de l'Internationale s'efforcent d'organiser la lutte contre un embrasement guerrier généralisé. En France le combat se polarise sur la loi portant trois ans la durée du service militaire et qui est adoptée par le Parlement malgré une intense campagne menée au cours du printemps et de l'été 1913 par Jaurès et les socialistes. En France le débat sur la représentation proportionnelle toujours présent est bousculé par de nouveaux thèmes d'affrontements : la réforme fiscale avec le projet d'impôt sur le revenu, les revendications féminines, la question de l'immigration qui s'ajoutent des thèmes plus traditionnels avec un syndicalisme qui lui aussi voit un changement. Que fait Jaurès pour penser dans le sens de l'émancipation ? Une recomposition politique assez confuse met aux prises radicaux modernes et nationalistes. Le parti socialiste SFIO obtient cent quatre-vingt-dix-sept députés aux législatives d'avril mai 1914 sans pouvoir non moins devenir maître du jeu politique. Jaurès s'efforce d'utiliser tous les moyens à sa disposition pour affirmer le socialisme et sauver la paix jusqu'à l'issue tragique. Un combat de plus en ces années de luttes marquées par la grève des cheminots ou la poursuite des débats sur les retraites qui mettent en jeu droits des travailleurs et primaires de l'état social. Dans les congrès nationaux et internationaux se forgent également les contours de l'identité socialiste au sein des controverses sur le rapport entretenir avec la francomanie ou le syndicalisme ou sur la position de L'Humanité journal du parti ou journal socialiste l'heure où les menaces s'accumulent où se pose la question des chemins à suivre pour le mouvement ouvrier.
