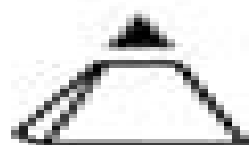

Oeuvres tome 15 Jean Jaurès, 2023-11-29 Guerre la guerre est le dernier tome paraître des œuvres de Jean Jaurès Il concerne une période particulièrement dramatique qui s'étend du 1er octobre 1912 jusqu'au 31 juillet 1914 date de l'assassinat de Jaurès et veille du déclenchement de la Première Guerre mondiale Il reprend le titre choisi par l'Internationale l'issue de son congrès de Bâle pour son appel à la mobilisation contre le danger de guerre Est-il possible de circonscrire les conflits qui ravagent les Balkans et de trouver des solutions pacifiques aux fortes tensions qui opposent entre elles les puissances européennes De grands rassemblements Paris et dans les autres capitales européennes des rencontres parlementaires Bâle comme Berne des tentatives de coordination au sein de l'Internationale s'efforcent d'organiser la lutte contre un embrasement guerrier généralisé En France le combat se polarise sur la loi portant trois ans la durée du service militaire et qui est adoptée par le Parlement malgré une intense campagne menée au cours du printemps et de l'été 1913 par Jaurès et les socialistes En France le débat sur la Représentation proportionnelle toujours présent est bousculé par de nouveaux thèmes d'affrontements la réforme fiscale avec le projet d'impôt sur le revenu les revendications féminines la question de l'immigration qui s'ajoutent des thèmes plus traditionnels avec un syndicalisme qui lui aussi veut changement que Jaurès cherche penser dans le sens de l'émancipation Une recomposition politique assez confuse met aux prises radicaux modérés et nationalistes Le parti socialiste SFIO obtient cent élus aux législatives d'avril-mai 1914 sans pouvoir néanmoins devenir maître du jeu politique Jaurès s'efforce d'utiliser tous les moyens à sa disposition pour affirmer le socialisme et sauver la paix jusqu'à l'issue tragique Cette édition est préparée par Marion Fontaine professeure des universités Sciences Po vice-présidente de la Société des études jaurésiennes et Christophe Prochasson directeur d'études à l'cole des hautes études en sciences sociales directeur de Mil Neuf Cent revue d'histoire intellectuelle **Œuvres de Maurice Thorez (9). Proudhon Pierre-Joseph Proudhon, 1924 *Encyclopédie des auteurs du pays Montluçonnais et de leurs œuvres (de 1440 à 1994)* Maurice Malleret, 1994-01-01T00:00:00+01:00 Apr s son ouvrage Pour voir Montlu on d une autre fa on devenu un classique Maurice Malleret nous offre ici le fruit de six ann es de recherches en un m ticuleux Who s Who de 370 auteurs du Pays montlu onnais recens s de 1440 1994 Cette encyclop die tablie chronologiquement recense galement les 2 500 titres d ouvrages publi s par ces auteurs quels que soient les sujets trait s L ensemble constituant le tr sor culturel litt raire et historique produit par ce Pays montlu onnais en plus de cinq si cles est ainsi offert au Bourbonnais et tous ses enfants en participation la marche de l esprit humain vers la connaissance de soi et du monde C est galement l apport de la culture locale la connaissance g n rale Ces biographies certaines tonnantes ou inattendues d autres bien modestes situent les auteurs dont 113 sont natifs de

Montlu on dans le temps et dans l'espace et les restituent la mémoire collective. Chaque page est une découverte. Ce travail original et sans précédent restera pour longtemps un ouvrage de référence pour les chercheurs et les lecteurs curieux de la vie de leur coin de France le Pays montluonnais ce territoire non défini géographiquement d'environ 3 660 kilomètres carrés correspondant la zone d'influence de Montluon qui mord incessamment sur les départements du Cher de la Creuse et du Puy de Dôme. Cette production intellectuelle qui ne connaît pas les limites administratives est contenue dans un cercle d'environ 30-35 kilomètres de diamètre. Le centre en est le vieux château des ducs de Bourbon cœur de la ville de Montluon qui devient ainsi comme l'indique Jean Charles Varennes dans sa préface un cœur vers lequel converge et déborde l'esprit. Travail de bénédictin mené avec la patience la ténacité et la méthode que les Montluonnais reconnaissent. Maurice Malleret cet ouvrage d'rudite est aussi un ouvrage de lecture qui passionnera et enrichira toute personne curieuse et intéressée par l'histoire des hommes et des femmes qui ont fait et font de leur petite patrie cette terre de création et de mutation que nous aimons le Bourbonnais. Jean Charles Varennes écrit aussi cet essai de muséologie littéraire est une réussite et il était nécessaire. Richement documenté finement détaillé agrémenté de 292 illustrations photographies documents portraits et signatures voici donc l'Encyclopédie des auteurs du Pays montluonnais et de leurs œuvres. Ce tome 2 qui s'insère dans la série qui prévoit 17 volumes et dont on a déjà publié 5 tomes couvre la période allant de l'attachement de Jaurès en septembre 1889 son retour aussi la Chambre en janvier 1893. Ces quatre années voient Jaurès universitaire et local issu d'un républicanisme exigeant mais modéré compagnon de route du radicalisme faire face la question sociale aux premiers grades comme l'institution des Bourses du Travail tous les débats de politique nationale ou internationale du temps. Le volume présente en outre un texte inédit important rédigé au cours de l'été 1891. La question sociale l'injustice du capitalisme et la révolution religieuse dont seul le dernier tiers était connu depuis sa publication en 1959 par Michel Launay. Cet inédit est essentiel la compréhension de l'évolution politique et intellectuelle de Jaurès au moment où il achève ses thèses déjà publiées dans le tome 3 paru en 2000 et s'interroge sur ses orientations personnelles sur la société et le monde dans lequel il vit.
