I noticed that those who refuse to move have more health problems than those who are trying to be active. Some of my colleagues said it was an attempt to complete fewer tasks but I believe this is a good strategy which makes patients more responsible, more active and, as a result, makes them healthier. Now I am using lots of her tricks to develop relationships with everybody and I have to say that she is a genius as all these tools really work.

As has been mentioned above, I believe I have chosen the right way and I am a good nurse who can function in all sites. However, I think that the ward is where the nurse belongs. I like being with patients and try to spend as much time as possible with them. I believe that patients need our psychological help even more than clinical services and I will go into detail on that matter below. I admire nurses who work in
