1. **Cellulose** (Polysaccharide) - The most abundant polysaccharide in nature, composed of glucose units linked by  $\beta$ -1,4 glycosidic bonds. It forms the structural component of plant cell walls.

2. **Starch** (Polysaccharide) - A storage polysaccharide in plants, composed of amylose (linear) and amylopectin (branched) units linked by  $\alpha$ -1,4 and  $\alpha$ -1,6 glycosidic bonds.

4. **Chitin** (Polysaccharide) - A structural polysaccharide found in the exoskeletons of arthropods and the cell walls of fungi, composed of N-acetylglucosamine units linked by  $\beta$ -1,4 glycosidic bonds.

5. **Pectin** (Polysaccharide) - A complex polysaccharide found in plant cell walls, composed of galacturonic acid units linked by  $\alpha$ -1,4 and  $\alpha$ -1,2 glycosidic bonds. It is involved in cell wall structure and fruit ripening.

6. **Hemicellulose** (Polysaccharide) - A structural polysaccharide found in plant cell walls, composed of various sugar units (glucose, mannose, galactose, xylose) linked by  $\beta$ -1,4 and  $\beta$ -1,6 glycosidic bonds.

7. **Xylan** (Polysaccharide) - A structural polysaccharide found in plant cell walls, composed of xylose units linked by  $\beta$ -1,4 glycosidic bonds.

8. **Arabinan** (Polysaccharide) - A structural polysaccharide found in plant cell walls, composed of arabinose units linked by  $\beta$ -1,4 and  $\beta$ -1,6 glycosidic bonds.

9. **Galactan** (Polysaccharide) - A structural polysaccharide found in plant cell walls, composed of galactose units linked by  $\beta$ -1,4 and  $\beta$ -1,6 glycosidic bonds.

10. **Mannan** (Polysaccharide) - A structural polysaccharide found in plant cell walls, composed of mannose units linked by  $\beta$ -1,4 and  $\beta$ -1,6 glycosidic bonds.

11. **Glucuronate** (Polysaccharide) - A structural polysaccharide found in plant cell walls, composed of glucuronic acid units linked by  $\beta$ -1,4 and  $\beta$ -1,6 glycosidic bonds.

12. **Glucosamine** (Polysaccharide) - A structural polysaccharide found in plant cell walls, composed of glucose units linked by  $\beta$ -1,4 and  $\beta$ -1,6 glycosidic bonds.

13. **Galactosamine** (Polysaccharide) - A structural polysaccharide found in plant cell walls, composed of galactose units linked by  $\beta$ -1,4 and  $\beta$ -1,6 glycosidic bonds.

14. **Mannosamine** (Polysaccharide) - A structural polysaccharide found in plant cell walls, composed of mannose units linked by  $\beta$ -1,4 and  $\beta$ -1,6 glycosidic bonds.

15. **Glucosaminic acid** (Polysaccharide) - A structural polysaccharide found in plant cell walls, composed of glucuronic acid units linked by  $\beta$ -1,4 and  $\beta$ -1,6 glycosidic bonds.

16. **Galactosaminic acid** (Polysaccharide) - A structural polysaccharide found in plant cell walls, composed of galacturonic acid units linked by  $\beta$ -1,4 and  $\beta$ -1,6 glycosidic bonds.
