Detailed design items are also provided especially relevant to the mining and oil and gas industries. Examples include pipe supports lifting analysis and dynamic machine foundation design. Steel theory is presented with information on fabrication transportation and costing along with member connection and anchor design. Concrete design includes information on construction costs as well as detailed calculations ranging from a simple beam design to the manual production of circular column interaction diagrams.
