Objective	When provided with the scrambled first letters of the mnemonic device PEMDAS (example: MSDEPA), students will be able to write the names of the operations in the correct order (parentheses, exponents, multiplication, division, addition, subtraction) and students should write the acronym they use to remember the Order of Operations (ex. Please Excuse My Dear Aunt Sally)
