Summary of assessment(s), including results and instructional implications:

D is a 12-year-old African American male who is currently attending regular 6th grade classes at Middle School. He is currently repeating 6th grade. D was referred by his 6th grade teachers due to chronic externalizing behavior problems and poor academic performance. D presents with cognitive abilities in the Deficient range (WISC-III Full Scale IQ=66), academic achievement scores that range from Borderline to Low Average (WJ-III Broad Reading=81, Broad Math=75, Broad Written Language=70), and documented deficits in the adaptive behavior (VABS Classroom Edition Communication=43, Daily Living Skills=64, Socialization=58). Results from the BASC indicate the presence of significant externalizing behavior problems, deficits in social adaptive skills, and deficits in attention and learning. D's deficits in cognitive abilities, academic skills, and adaptive behavior are indicative of mild mental retardation and are contributing significantly to his externalizing behavior problems in the classroom setting. It is not apparent that D's behavior problems are indicative of an emotional disturbance. It is recommended that D be considered by the evaluation team for primary special education placement in Developmentally Handicapped (DH) with behavioral support services provided as needed.
