A Velvet Empire David Todd, 2023-09-26 How France's elites used soft power to pursue their imperial ambitions in the nineteenth century After Napoleon's downfall in 1815 France embraced a mostly informal style of empire one that emphasized economic and cultural influence rather than military conquest A Velvet Empire is a global history of French imperialism in the nineteenth century providing new insights into the mechanisms of imperial collaboration that extended France's power from the Middle East to Latin America and ushered in the modern age of globalization David Todd shows how French elites pursued a cunning strategy of imperial expansion in which conspicuous commodities such as champagne and silk textiles together with loans to client states contributed to a global campaign of seduction French imperialism was no less brutal than that of the British But while Britain widened its imperial reach through settler colonialism and the acquisition of far flung territories France built a velvet empire backed by frequent military interventions and a broadening extraterritorial jurisdiction Todd demonstrates how France drew vast benefits from these asymmetric imperial like relations until a succession of setbacks around the world brought about their unravelling in the 1870s A Velvet Empire sheds light on France's neglected contribution to the conservative reinvention of modernity and offers a new interpretation of the resurgence of French colonialism on a global scale after 1880 This panoramic book also highlights the crucial role of collaboration among European empires during this period including archrivals Britain and France and cooperation with indigenous elites in facilitating imperial expansion and the globalization of capitalism

The Plebeian Experience Martin Breaugh, 2013-12-10 How do people excluded from political life achieve political agency Through a series of historical events that have been mostly overlooked by political theorists Martin Breaugh identifies fleeting yet decisive instances of emancipation in which people took it upon themselves to become political subjects Emerging during the Roman plebs's first secession in 494 BCE the plebeian experience consists of an underground or unexplored configuration of political strategies to obtain political freedom The people reject domination through political praxis and concerted action therefore establishing an alternative form of power Breaugh's study concludes in the nineteenth century and integrates ideas from sociology philosophy history and political science Organized around diverse case studies his work undertakes exercises in

political theory to show how concepts provide a different understanding of the meaning of historical events and our political present The Plebeian Experience describes a recurring phenomenon that clarifies struggles for emancipation throughout history expanding research into the political agency of the many and shedding light on the richness of radical democratic struggles from ancient Rome to Occupy Wall Street and beyond

Hutton, 2023-11-10 This pathbreaking study deals with the thought and activities of the disciples of the renowned revolutionary Auguste Blanqui from the later years of the French Second Empire 1860s through the crisis attending the political campaign of General Boulanger 1880s It explores the mythological significance of Blanqui for the French Left the atheist thoughts of the Blanquists as the foundation of their revolutionary politics the role of the Blanquists in the Paris Commune of 1871 the relationship between Blanquist and Marxist ideologies and the influence of the Blanquists as promoters of the cult of the Revolutionary tradition in the early years of the Third Republic The Cult of the Revolutionary Tradition is the first comprehensive study of the Blanquists to appear in French or English It is also the first to treat seriously the impact of the legend of Blanqui upon his followers and admirers In tracing their changing conception of the revolutionary cause from its sources in the radical thought of a Parisian youth movement to its perversion in the proto fascist doctrine of some aging Blanquists employed myth and ritual to popularize their ideas and how in the end their efforts to do so transformed their revolutionary party into a conservative sect Hutton takes issue with the standard interpretation of the Blanquists as unreflective precursors of the Marxists Far from contributing to Marxist Socialism he contends the Blanquists began with different theoretical assumption and developed a different model of revolution In describing the antagonisms between Blanquists guardians of the French Revolutionary tradition and Marxists apostles of a new Socialism the author reveals the obstacles which stood in the way of a unified revolutionary movement in the Third Republic and sheds light on the ideological divisions which have plagued the French Left ever since The study raises issues which transcend the French revolutionary experience In analyzing the Blanquists' conception of revolution as an ultimate concern it underscores the parallels between religious and revolutionary consciousness Through the investigation of the myths and rituals of Blanquist revolutionary practice it offers some observations on the nature of the revolutionary mentality and some perspective upon the phenomenon of revolution in general This title is part of UC Press's Voices Revived program which commemorates University of California Press's mission to seek out and cultivate the brightest minds and give them voice reach and impact Drawing on a backlist dating to 1893 Voices Revived makes high quality peer reviewed scholarship accessible once again

Burton, 2018-10-18 The Terror of 1793 94 the Paris Commune of 1871 the Dreyfus Affair explosions of violence punctuated French history from the start of the Revolution until the Liberation at the close of World War II The distinguished scholar Richard D E Burton here offers a stunningly original account of these outbursts concluding that recourse to political violence was not occasional and abnormal but rather the usual pattern in French history Instead of adhering to conventional chronological lines Blood in the City is structured topologically around a number of major Parisian sites of memory including Place de la Concorde Sacr Coeur and the Eiffel Tower For thirty years Burton has visited and revisited Paris criss crossing the streets on foot and lived with great nineteenth and twentieth century literary depictions of the city Drawing on historical literary visual anthropological and psychological sources he develops a wide ranging account of violence in modern French politics In so doing he provides powerful insights into political violence scapegoating the idea of sacrifice and the widespread French obsession with conspiracy Burton demonstrates that time and again the same basic scenario has been acted out on the streets of Paris one or more people would be singled out from the community and imprisoned exiled or more often subjected to violence by the crowd or the state In particular he explores how Catholicism in its extreme ultrareactionary form shaped the worldviews of Parisians and how the killing of a sacrificial victim came to be seen as a reenactment of the crucifixion of Christ
