5 practical knowledge and skills 6 adaptation 7 professional networking and 8 9 perceived benefits to teachers and students Chaos complexity theory was used to identify the major attractors goals for teachers self directed professional development using ICT Two attractors were identified These were personal professional development and classroom practice However an over riding factor common to both attractors was identified as self efficacy. The study identified the over arching driver for self directed professional development as the teacher's need to improve their self efficacy.
