Volcances are mountains - except for one significant difference. Below the surface lies malten rock. When volcances erupt, rock fragments and gas flow up through the top and cause trigger avalanches, earthquakes, tsunamis, mudslides, flooding, and release ash and rockfalls.

Beneath the earth's outer crust lies the mantle. The mantle stretches 1,800 miles deep and is composed to silicate rocks, high in iron and magnesium. Heat from the earth's core makes the rocks rise, then cool, then move again towards the core. When magma from the mantle moves toward the earth's surface, it may erupt and form ash deposits or lava flows. The magma moves towards the surface because the solid rock is more dense than the magma. Volcanoes actually increase in size with repeated eruptions.

Volcances are classified as either dormant, extinct, or active. Dormant volcances have not erupted in many year, but could possibly erupt, whereas with an extinct volcano, it has already erupted and there is no chance it will erupt again. Active volcances have erupted recently and might erupt again. The earths crust is fragmented into tectonic plates. These plates fit together across the earth, and the plates moved in different ways. Some of these tectonic movements cause volcances to erupt near the plates' edges.

Volcances may be one of several shapes: cinder cone, shield, or stratovolcances. Cinder cone volcances
