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Methods of Transliteration

ISO 9-1995

The ISO 9 standard provides a consistent transliteration system widely used in academia and research.

BGN/PCGN

Developed for geographical names, this system is commonly used in cartography and international organizations.

GOST 7.79-2000

A Russian national standard used for transliterating Russian documents and publications.

Scientific Transliteration

This method prioritizes accuracy and phonetic consistency, often used in linguistic studies.
