Investigations Into the Origins of Polyatomic Ions in Inductively Coupled Plasma-mass Spectrometry, 2010 An inductively coupled plasma mass spectrometer ICP MS is an elemental analytical instrument capable of determining nearly all elements in the periodic table at limits of detection in the parts per quadrillion and with a linear analytical range over 8-10 orders of magnitude Three concentric quartz tubes make up the plasma torch Argon gas is spiraled through the outer tube and generates the plasma powered by a looped load coil operating at 27.1 or 40.6 MHz The argon flow of the middle channel is used to keep the plasma above the innermost tube through which solid or aqueous sample is carried in a third argon stream A sample is progressively desolvated atomized and ionized The torch is operated at atmospheric pressure To reach the reduced pressures of mass spectrometers ions are extracted through a series of two approximately one millimeter wide circular apertures set in water cooled metal cones The space between the cones is evacuated to approximately one torr The space behind the second cone is pumped down to or near to the pressure needed for the mass spectrometer MS The first cone called the sampler is placed directly in the plasma plume and its position is adjusted to the point where atomic ions are most abundant The hot plasma gas expands through the sampler orifice and in this expansion is placed the second cone called the skimmer After the skimmer traditional MS designs are employed i.e. quadrupoles magnetic sectors time of flight ICP MS is the leading trace element analysis technique One of its weaknesses are polyatomic ions This dissertation has added to the fundamental understanding of some of these polyatomic ions their origins and behavior Although mainly continuing the work of others certain novel approaches have been introduced here Chapter 2 includes the first reported efforts to include high temperature corrections to the partition functions of the polyatomic ions in ICP MS This and other objections to preceding papers in this area were addressed Errors in the measured T_{sub} gas values were found for given errors in the experimental and spectroscopic values The ionization energy of the neutral polyatomic ion was included in calculations to prove the validity of ignoring more complicated equilibria Work was begun on the question of agreement between kinetics of the plasma and interface and the increase and depletion seen in certain polyatomic ions This dissertation was also the first to report day to day ranges for T_{sub} gas values and to use a statistical test to compare different operating conditions This will help guide comparisons of previous and future work Chapter 4 was the first attempt to include the excited electronic state 2 in the partition function of ArO as well as the first to address the different dissociation products of the ground and first electronic levels of ArO Chapter 5 reports an interesting source of memory in ICP MS that could affect mathematical corrections for polyatomic ions For future work on these topics I suggest the following experiments and investigations Clearly not an extensive list they are instead the first topics curiosity brings to mind
