

Number

...or **NUMB**, for the correct order of operations, take care when using a calculator.

- Brackets
- Orders (or powers)
- Division and Multiplication
- Addition and Subtraction

Types of number

Integer: a 'whole' number
Factors: the divisors of an integer
• Factors of 12 are 1, 2, 3, 4, 6, 12
Multiples: a 'times table' for an integer (with infinite multiples)
• Multiples of 12 are 12, 24, 36, ...
Prime numbers: an integer which has exactly two factors (1 and the number itself). Note it is not a prime number.

Units

Highest Common Factor (HCF)
• Factors of 6 are 1, 2, 3, 6
Factors of 9 are 1, 3, 9
HCF of 6 and 9 is 3

Lowest Common Multiple (LCM)

• Multiples of 6 are 6, 12, 18, 24, ...
Multiples of 9 are 9, 18, 27, 36, ...
LCM of 6 and 9 is 18

Power notation

Write a number as a product of its prime factors, and follow for repeated factors.
• $120 = 2 \times 2 \times 2 \times 3 \times 5$

Indices and roots

Special indices for any value a
 $a^0 = 1$
 $a^{-1} = \frac{1}{a}$
 $a^{\frac{1}{2}} = \sqrt{a}$

Ordering with fractions

Adding or subtracting fractions, use a common denominator.
• $\frac{1}{2} + \frac{1}{3} = \frac{3}{6} + \frac{2}{6} = \frac{5}{6}$

Multiplying fractions

Multiplying fractions: multiply numerators and denominators.
• $\frac{1}{2} \times \frac{1}{3} = \frac{1 \times 1}{2 \times 3} = \frac{1}{6}$

Dividing fractions

Dividing fractions: 'flip' the second fraction, then multiply.
• $\frac{1}{2} \div \frac{1}{3} = \frac{1}{2} \times \frac{3}{1} = \frac{3}{2}$

Prime factors

Factorise an integer as a product of its prime factors.
• $12 = 2 \times 2 \times 3$

Least common multiple

Least common multiple (LCM) is the smallest number that is a multiple of two or more numbers.
• LCM of 6 and 9 is 18

Algebra

Look for the biggest square number factor of the coefficient.
• $100 = 10 \times 10$

Standard form

Standard form numbers are of the form: $a \times 10^n$ where $1 \leq a < 10$ and n is an integer.

Scientific notation

1 atom = 0.000 000 1 kilograms
1 kilogram = 1 000 grams
1 kilometre = 1 000 metres
1 metre = 100 centimetres
1 centimetre = 10 millimetres

Units

1 day = 24 hours
1 hour = 60 minutes = 3 600 seconds
1 minute = 60 seconds

Ordering

Transfer the number, then add or 'bigger' digit to moved up or down.
Decimal places: use the decimal point.

Ordering

100 000 000 = 100 million
10 000 000 = 10 million
1 000 000 = 1 million
100 000 = 100 000

Ordering

Find the range of numbers that will result in a given value.
• $x = 5$ (2 decimal places)
 $5.000 \leq x < 5.005$

Ordering

• $x = 10$ (1 significant figure)
 $10 \leq x < 11$

Ordering

Note use of $\leq$ and $<$, and that the last significant figure is in 5.

Ordering

It is important to find the same particular value of x .
• $2x + 1 = 5$ then $x = 2$
• $2x + 1 = 5$ then $x = 2$

Ordering

For any value x
 $a^2 + b^2 = c^2$
 $a^2 + b^2 = c^2$
 $a^2 + b^2 = c^2$

Ordering

• $(\frac{1}{2})^2 = \frac{1}{4}$
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Geometry & measures

Look for the biggest square number factor of the coefficient.
• $100 = 10 \times 10$

Ordering

Equation of straight line $y = mx + c$ as in the gradient m is the y intercept c .
• Find the equation of the line that joins (0, 2) to (2, 1).
Find the gradient.
 $m = \frac{1 - 2}{2 - 0} = -\frac{1}{2}$
