Existentialism Jonathan Webber, 2018-07-18 In Rethinking Existentialism Jonathan Webber articulates an original interpretation of existentialism as the ethical theory that human freedom is the foundation of all other values Offering an original analysis of classic literary and philosophical works published by Jean Paul Sartre Simone de Beauvoir and Frantz Fanon up until 1952 Webber's conception of existentialism is developed in critical contrast with central works by Albert Camus Sigmund Freud and Maurice Merleau Ponty Presenting his arguments in an accessible and engaging style Webber contends that Beauvoir and Sartre initially disagreed over the structure of human freedom in 1943 but Sartre ultimately came to accept Beauvoir's view over the next decade He develops the viewpoint that Beauvoir provides a more significant argument for authenticity than either Sartre or Fanon He articulates in detail the existentialist theories of individual character and the social identities of gender and race key concerns in current discourse Webber concludes by sketching out the broader implications of his interpretation of existentialism for philosophy psychology and psychotherapy **English**

Ian Birchall Betsy Bowman and Bob Stone Azzedine Haddour Ronald Aronson William L McBride **Aristophanes with the English Translation of Benjamin Bickley Rogers** Aristophanes, 1927 **Simone de Beauvoir, Philosophy, & Feminism** Nancy Bauer, 2001 In the introduction to *The Second Sex* Simone de Beauvoir notes that a man never begins by establishing himself as an individual of a certain sex his being a man poses no problem Nancy Bauer begins her book by asking Then what kind of a problem does being a woman pose Bauer's aim is to show that in answering this question *The Second Sex* dramatizes the extent to which being a woman poses a philosophical problem In exploring what it might mean to philosophize as a woman Beauvoir produced a book that not only sparked the contemporary feminist movement but also Bauer argues made an important but still profoundly undervalued contribution to the philosophical tradition **Politics, Writing, Mutilation** Allan Stoekl, 1985 *Politics Writing Mutilation* was first published in 1985 Minnesota Archive Editions uses digital technology to make long unavailable books once again accessible and are published unaltered from the original University of Minnesota Press editions Five twentieth century French writers played and continue to play a pivotal role in the development of literary philosophical thinking that has come to be known in the United States as post structuralism The work of Georges Bataille Maurice Blanchot Raymond Roussel Michel Leiris and Francis Ponge in the 1930s and 1940s amounts to a prehistory of today's theoretical debates the writings of Foucault and Derrida in particular would have been unthinkable outside the context provided by these writers In *Politics Writing Mutilation* Allan Stoekl emphasizes their role as precursors but he also makes clear that they created a distinctive body of work that must be read and evaluated on its own terms Stoekl's critical readings of their work selected novels poems and autobiographical fragments reveal them to be battlegrounds not only of disruptive language practices but of conflicting political drives as well These irreconcilable tendencies can be defined as progressive political revolution on the one hand with its emphasis on utility conservation and labor and on the other hand a notion of dangerous and sinister production that stresses orgiastic sexuality and delirious expenditure Caught between these forces is the intellectual of Bataille's time and indeed of ours locked in impotence self betrayal and automutilation Stoekl develops his critique through dual readings of each writer's central work the first reading deconstructive the second a search for the political meaning excluded by a deconstructive approach Repeating this process on a larger scale he shows how Derrida and Foucault are indebted to their precursors even while they have betrayed them by stripping their work of political conflict and historical specificity And he acknowledges that one of the most painful questions faced in prewar and Occupied France that of the unthinkable guilt and duplicity of the intellectual may not be as remote from contemporary theoretical concerns as some would have us believe **Dada and Existentialism** Elizabeth Benjamin, 2016-08-30 Offering new critical approaches to Dada as quintessential part of the Avant Garde *Dada and Existentialism* the Authenticity of Ambiguity reassesses the movement as a form of proto Existentialist philosophy Dada is often dismissed as an anti art movement with a merely destructive theoretical impetus French Existentialism is often condemned for its perceived quietist

The Phenomenological Movement Herbert Spiegelberg, 2013-11-11 The present attempt to introduce the general philosophical reader to the Phenomenological Movement by way of its history has itself a history which is pertinent to its objective It may suitably be opened by the following excerpts from a review which Herbert W Schneider of Columbia University the Head of the Division for International Cultural Cooperation Department of Cultural Activities of Unesco from 1953 to 56 wrote in 1950 from France The influence of Husserl has revolutionized continental philosophies not because his philosophy has become dominant but because any philosophy now seeks to accommodate itself to and express itself in phenomenological method It is the sine qua non of critical respectability In America on the contrary phenomenology is in its infancy The average American student of philosophy when he picks up a recent volume of philosophy published on the continent of Europe must first learn the tricks of the phenomenological trade and then translate as best he can the real import of what is said into the kind of analysis with which he is familiar No doubt American education will gradually take account of the spread of phenomenological method and terminology but until it does American readers of European philosophy have a severe handicap and this applies not only to existentialism but to almost all current philosophical literature
