1. E.g. Mrs Medlock is wearing a bonnet, which is an item of clothing that people don't wear anymore. She works as a housekeeper for Mr Craven, and few people have housekeepers today. Some of the language used, like "pettish" and "railway carriage", is also old fashioned.
2. E.g. The description of Mary makes her sound plain and miserable, and her hair is described as "limp" which means that it looks lifeless. Normally, heroines are described very positively, but Mary sounds boring and not very likeable.
3. E.g. Mrs Medlock thinks that Mary is spoilt, which suggests that she doesn't like Mary very much. She also thinks that Mary is strange because she sits "so still". She compares Mary to an "old woman", which shows that she doesn't think Mary acts like a normal child.
4. E.g. Mary means that she doesn't have a choice about going to live with her uncle now that her parents have died, so it doesn't matter what he is like. It could also mean that Mary is so upset about the death of her parents that nothing matters to her now.
5. E.g. They both have quite cold personalities. Neither of them are close to their family, and they don't seem upset about the death of Mary's parents. They are both unfriendly towards Mrs Medlock — Mary doesn't want to be seen with her and Mr Craven gives her orders without thinking about how they affect her life.
