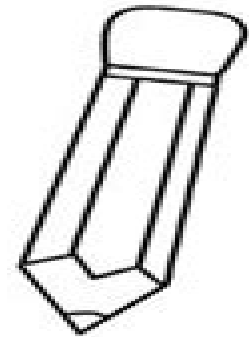


Dialogue

1. At the beginning of a sentence.

2. At the end of a sentence.

Krista said, "I can't wait for school to start."

3. In the middle of a sentence.

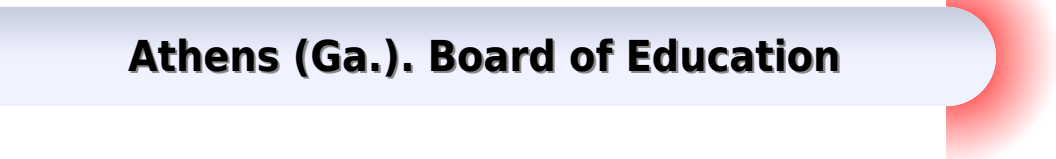
"I can't wait for school to start," Krista said, "But, I will miss sleeping in."

Rules for Using Dialogue:

- For every new speaker, begin a new line.
- Capitalize the first letter of dialogue.
- Punctuation such as commas and periods go inside the quotation marks.
- Dialogue and the speaker need to be separated by a comma, exclamation point, or question mark.
