Have you ever seen a shooting star? Shooting stars happen anytime, because they are hot balls of light. They can travel as fast as 100,000 miles per hour! If you have seen one, you've actually seen a meteor (it flows through space). Earth's surface isn't as hot as these chunks of hot rocks, and gas that flows through our (200,000). They can be as small as a grain of sand or as large as a house.
