Elleke Boehmer, 2025-12-30 A new compass for global reading looking at the world from the far southern latitudes A northern viewpoint is most often the default while the south the far southern latitudes occupied by Australia New Zealand Argentina and southern Africa among others seems far away and ignorable In Southern Imagining Elleke Boehmer offers an alternative perspective using literary scientific and cultural material to explore how we look at the world from the south Reading she argues is a transformative means of reversing our usual planetary orientation and rearranging our perceptual geography Boehmer examines writing from across southern continents and islands considering how we imaginatively inhabit the farthest reaches of our planet Creators ranging from the Portuguese epic poet Lu s de Cam es to Samuel Taylor Coleridge Charles Darwin Katherine Mansfield Jorge Luis Borges and ancient Indigenous storytellers capture the edgy and austere experiences of the far south For Boehmer imaginative work stimulates and shapes our phenomenological understanding Southerners often see themselves as far away from where things count as outsiders internalising the wider global sense of their relative insignificance Conversely when northerners read or hear legends narratives songs and poems from the south it is as if they are located in the south at least for the duration of the reading or listening Boehmer suggests that the south

tilted world map re centred through song and story invites us to claim a more involved sense of belonging to our planet both its north and its south The writers of the south disrupt conventional ways of seeing and invite us to inhabit our globe differently

Norton of Everest Hugh Norton, 2017-05-11 Major Norton gave the order to fire two or three times Their advanced machine gunners could be seen rushing forward and establishing themselves in commanding posts Almost at once the ridge we were occupying was swept by machine gun fire E F Norton lived a life of distinction in the declining years of the British Empire Born into an accomplished well travelled family he followed his heart and enlisted for a professional career as a soldier A distinguished military career followed punctuated with indulgences in his passion for exploration and mountaineering The British Empire was starting to crumble and Norton would be called upon more than once to rise to a variety of challenges Norton s gift for leadership was first demonstrated via his rapid progression through the ranks in the First World War which paved the way for future leadership appointments having earned the confidence and respect of those under his command Events in the Second World War followed suit when Norton was abruptly assigned the post of acting governor of Hong Kong entrusted to save the civilian population from imminent Japanese invasion The 1924 Everest expedition also exemplifies the pattern of having had leadership thrust upon him in this case when General Charles Bruce was struck down by malaria on the approach march Leading from the front Norton set an altitude record for climbing on Everest without supplementary oxygen a record only bettered in 1978 when Reinhold Messner and Peter Habeler made the first ascent of Everest without oxygen Yet tragedy would follow Norton s achievement when George Mallory and Andrew Irvine disappeared high on the mountain In *Norton of Everest* Hugh Norton has written sensitively and knowledgably about his father s remarkable life as mountaineer soldier naturalist artist and family man As on Everest the real story is not only the death of the gallant but also the heroics of the quiet survivors like E F Norton
