Studies of human fathers and their infants confirm that many fathers can act sensitively with their infant (according to Parke & Sawin, 1980) and their infants form attachments to both their mothers and fathers at roughly the same age (according to Lamb, 1977). A number of studies have been done on the caretaker's effects on the child and suggests that the effects may have been caused by child's behavior as much as by the caretaker's (according to Bell 1979).
